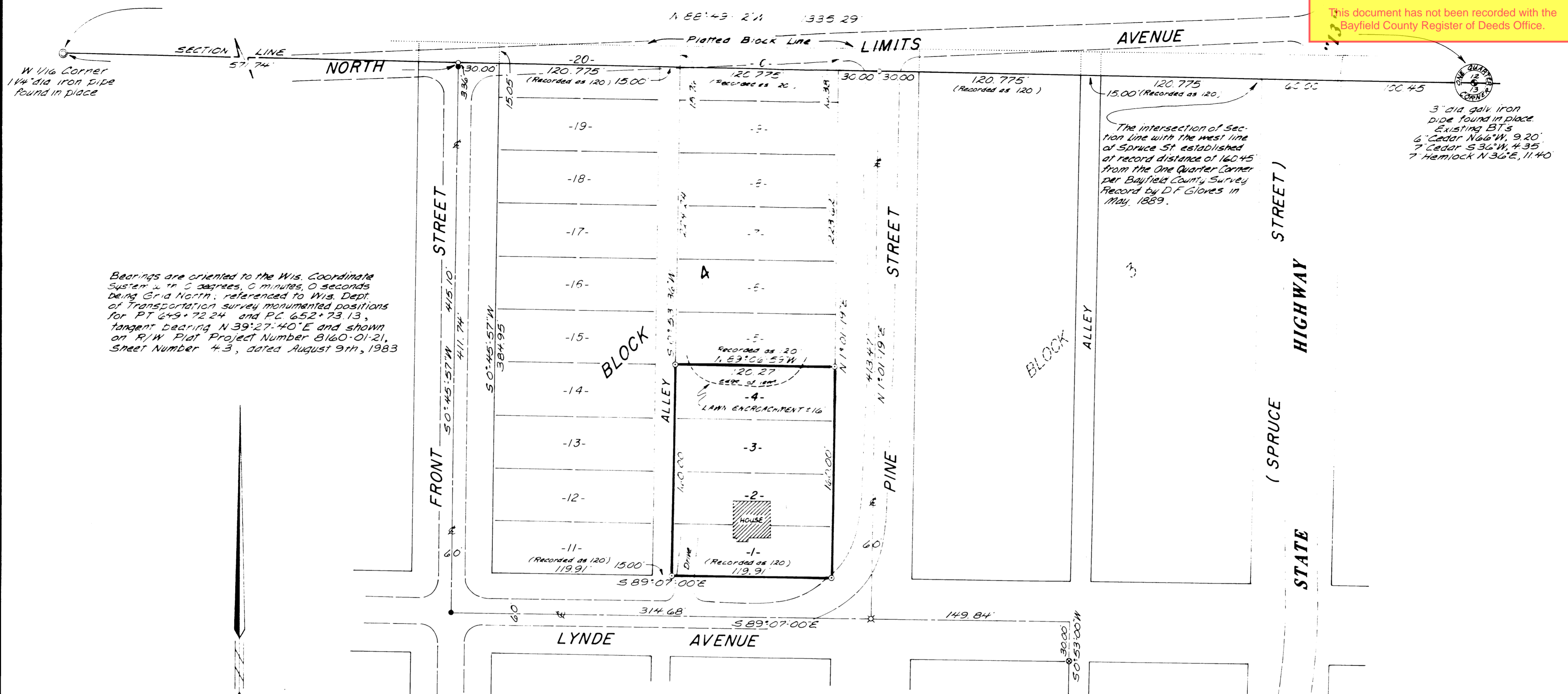


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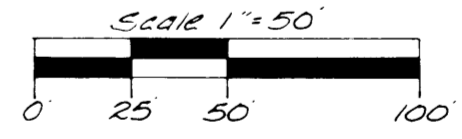

3" dia galv. iron pipe found in place. Existing BT's 6" Cedar N 66°W, 9.20' 7" Cedar S 36°W, 4.35' 7" Hemlock N 36°E, 11.40'
