

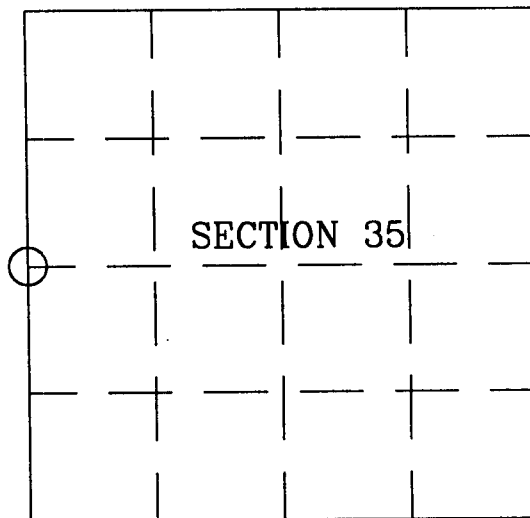
## BAYFIELD COUNTY LAND SURVEY MONUMENT RECORD

INSTRUCTIONS: This record shall show the location of the corner and shall include all of the following nine elements (a through i).

(a) Identify the corner by reference to the U.S. public land survey system.

○ = Corner monument restored.

West 1/4 corner of Section 35, T.52N., R.4W., in the Town of Russell, Bayfield County, Wisconsin.



(b) Describe any record evidence, monument evidence, occupational evidence, testimonial evidence or any other material evidence you considered, and whether the monument was found or placed.

Found a 2-1/2" iron pipe with a 3" cap that is stamped to identify the corner. Pipe was set by T. W. Nelson, R.L.S.-263 in May of 1960 to replace a squared maple post he found. This corner was used by T.W. Nelson to subdivide Section 35.
