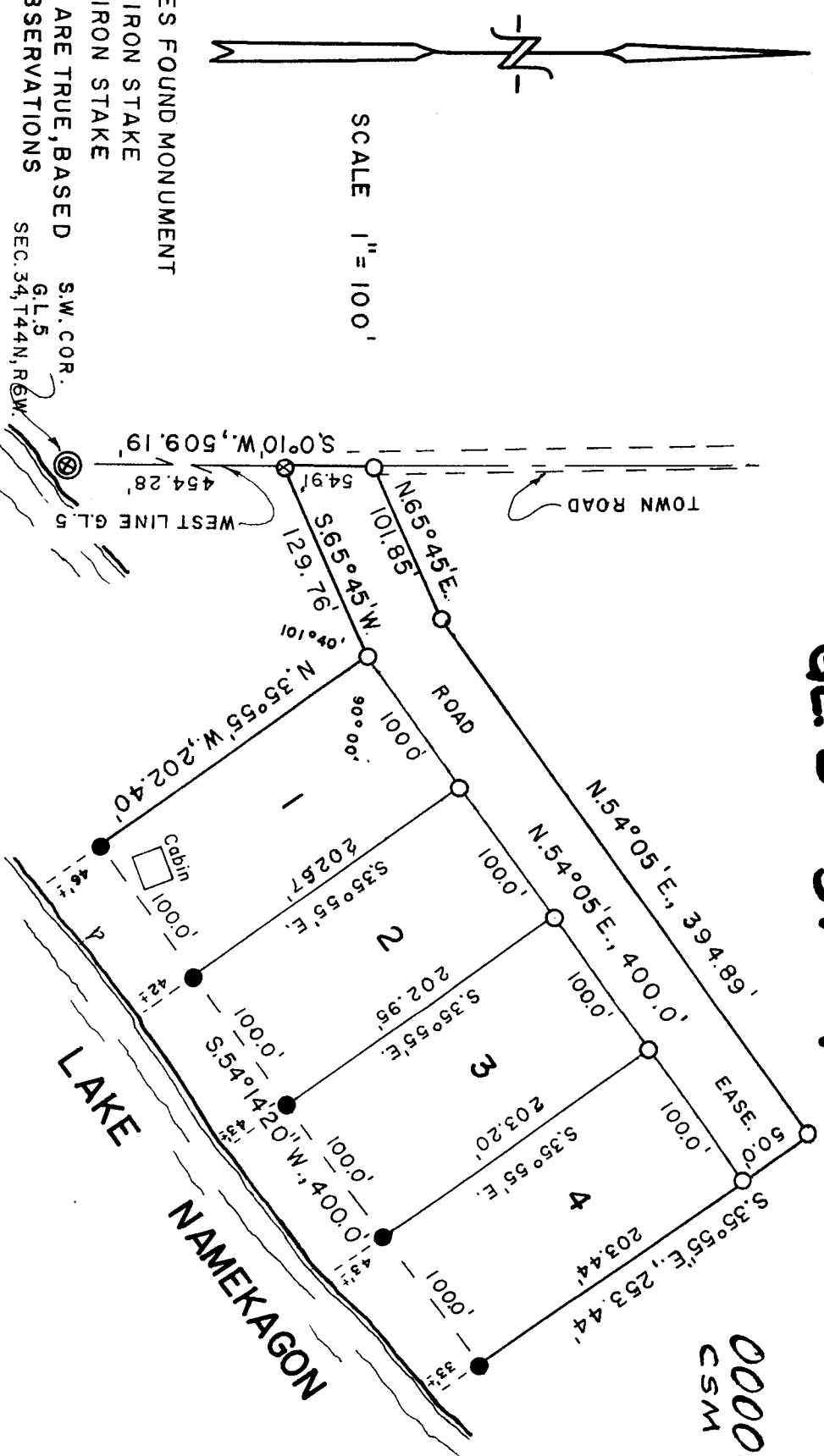

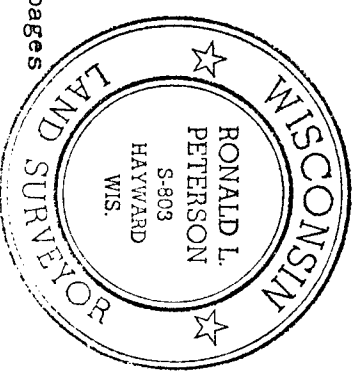

Part of Govt. Lot 5 Sec. 34, T. 44 N. R.6 W. described as follows; Commencing at the southwest corner of said Govt. Lot 5, Thence N. 0°10'E, along the west line of said Govt. Lot 5, 454.28 feet to the actual point of beginning, Thence continue N. 0°10'E, along the west line of said Govt. Lot 5, 54.91 feet, Thence N. 65°45' E, 101.85 feet, Thence N. 54°05'E, 394.89 feet, Thence S. 35°55'E, 253.44 feet to the meander corner on the northerly shore of Lake Namekagon, said meander corner being 33 feet more or less from the waters edge, Thence S. 54°14'20"W. along the meander line of Lake Namekagon 400.0 feet to the end of the meander line, said point being 46 feet more or less from the waters edge, Thence N. 35°55'W, 202.40 feet, Thence S. 65°45'W, 129.76 feet to the point of beginning, and including all the land between the meander line and the waters edge of Lake Namekagon, between the parcel lines extended. All subject to easements and reservations of record.
