

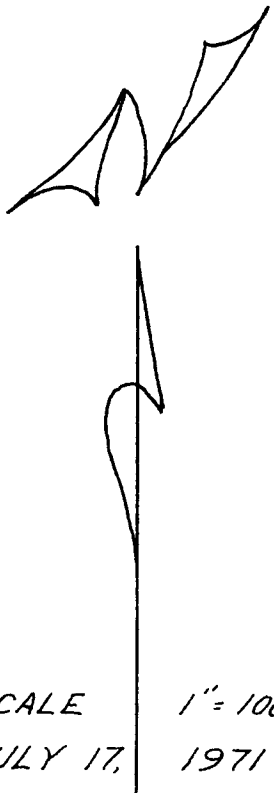

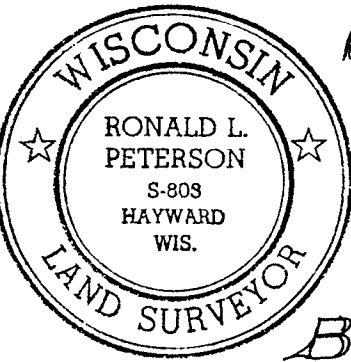

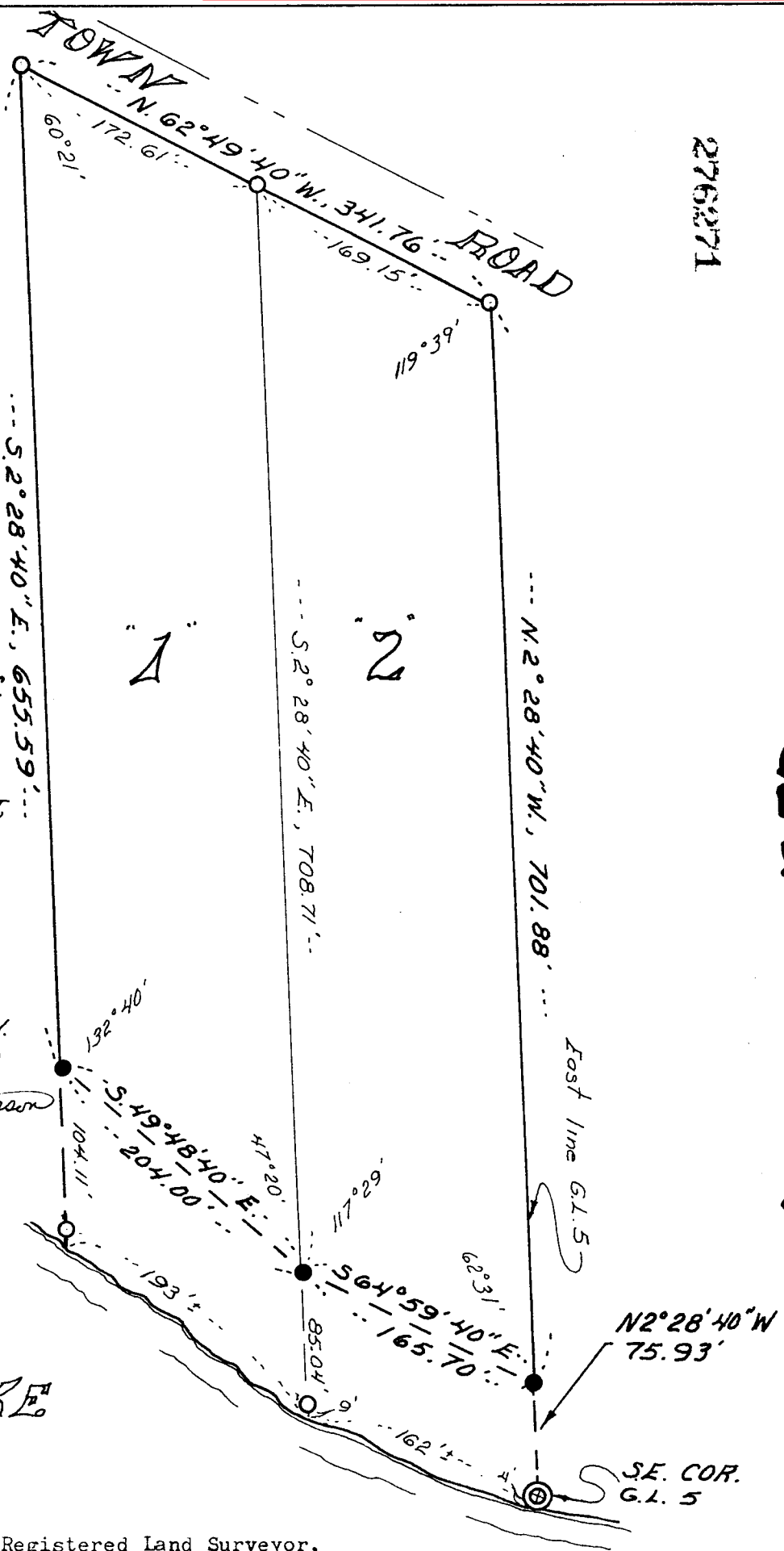

Commencing at the southeast corner of said Govt. Lot 5, being 1" Steel fence
post on the northerly shore of Bony Lake, Thence N. 2°28'40"W, 75.93 feet
to the meander corner and the actual point of beginning, Thence continue
N. 2°28'40" W. along the east line of said Govt. Lot 5, 701.88 feet to
the southerly right-of-way line of the town road, Thence N. 62°49'40"W,
along said southerly right-of-way line, 341.76 feet, Thence S. 2°28'40" E,
655.59 feet to the meander corner on the northerly shore of Bony Lake,
Thence along the meander line as follows, S. 49°48'40" E, 204.00 feet,
Thence S. 64°59'40" E, 165.70 feet to the end of said meander line and
the point of beginning, and including all the land between the meander
