SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, Thomas W. Nelson, Registered Land Surveyor, hereby certify that on the order of Jerome Wrolson, I have surveyed and mapped the following described parcel of land located in Gov't Lot 1, Section 1, T.44N., R.9W., in Bayfield County, Wisconsin.

To locate the Point of Beginning, commence at the West 1/4 corner of Section 1 and run North, along the West line of Section 1, 1322.59', to a 1" iron pipe on the North R.O.W. of the Smith Lake Road; Thence continuing along said North R.O.W. N68°52'33"E, 428.68'; Thence S89°56'45"E, 66.00' to a 2" iron pipe on the North R.O.W. of the Smith Lake Road and on the East R.O.W. of a Private Drive to the North, which is the Point of Beginning.

Thence from said Point of Beginning by metes and bounds, S89°56'45"E, along the North R.O.W. of the Smith Lake Road, 907.85' Thence leaving the North R.O.W., N00°16'15"W, 342.00' to the South R.O.W. of a Private Drive; Thence continuing along said South R.O.W., N89°56'45"W, 559.34'; Thence S68°01'45"W, 374.06'; Thence South, 201.72' to the Point of Beginning. Parcel contains 6.56 Acres.

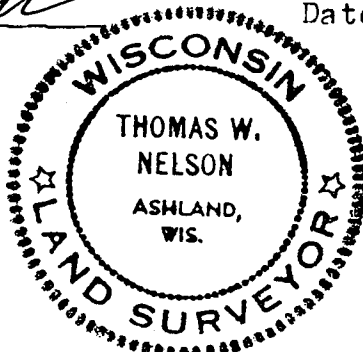
That this Certified Survey Map is a correct representation of all the exterior boundaries of the land surveyed and the subdivision thereof.
