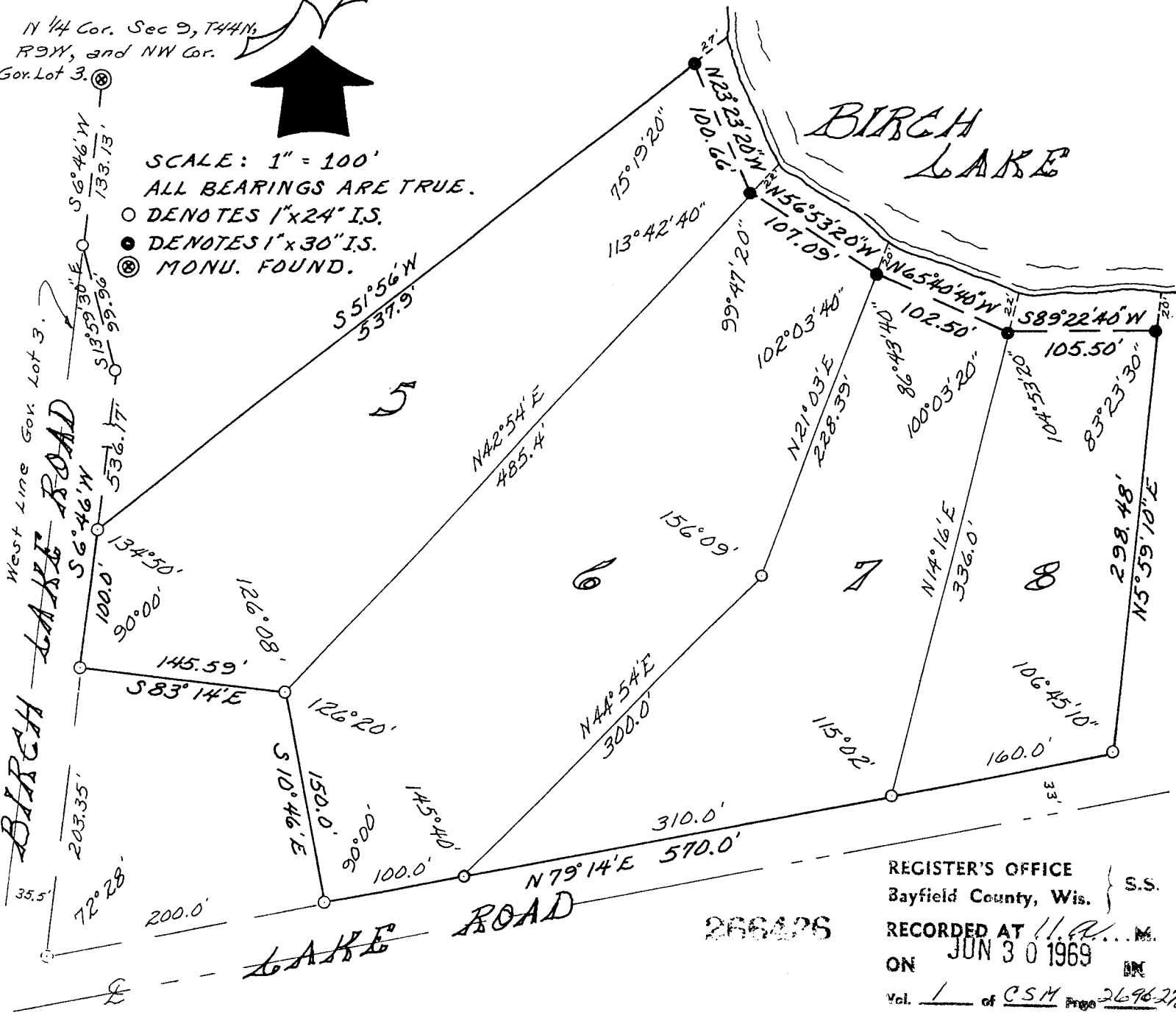


N 1/4 Cor. Sec 9, T44N, R9W, and NW Cor. Gov. Lot 3.

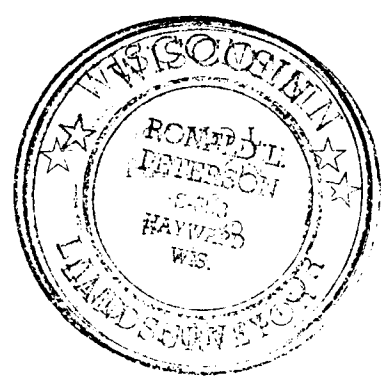

Risberg, Owner of said land, I have surveyed, divided and mapped the land herein described, and that such map is a correct representation of the land surveyed, and that this land is located in Government Lot Three (3), Section Nine (9), Township Forty-four (44) North, Range Nine (9) West, Bayfield County, Wisconsin, described as follows:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of Government Lot Three (3), Section Nine (9), Township Forty-four (44) North, Range Nine (9) West; thence South 6°46' West, 133.13 feet along the West line of said Government Lot 3 to the northeasterly right of way line of Birch Lake Road; thence South 13°59'30" East along said right of way line 99.96 feet; thence South 6°46' West along said easterly right of way line 536.17 feet to the actual point of beginning; thence continue South 6°46' West 100.0 feet along said easterly right of way line, thence South 83°14' East, 145.59 feet; thence South 10°46' East, 150.0 feet to the northerly right of way line of Lake Road; thence North 79°14' East along said northerly right of way line 570.0 feet; thence North 5°59'10" East, 298.48 feet to the meander corner on the southerly shore of Birch Lake; thence along the meander line as follows: South 89°22'40" West, 105.5 feet; thence North 65°40'40" West, 102.5 feet; thence North 56°53'20" West, 107.09 feet; thence North 23°23'20" West, 100.66 feet to the end of the meander line; thence South 51°56' West, 537.9 feet to the point of beginning, and including all the land between the meander line and the water's edge of Birch Lake between the parcel lines extended.
