

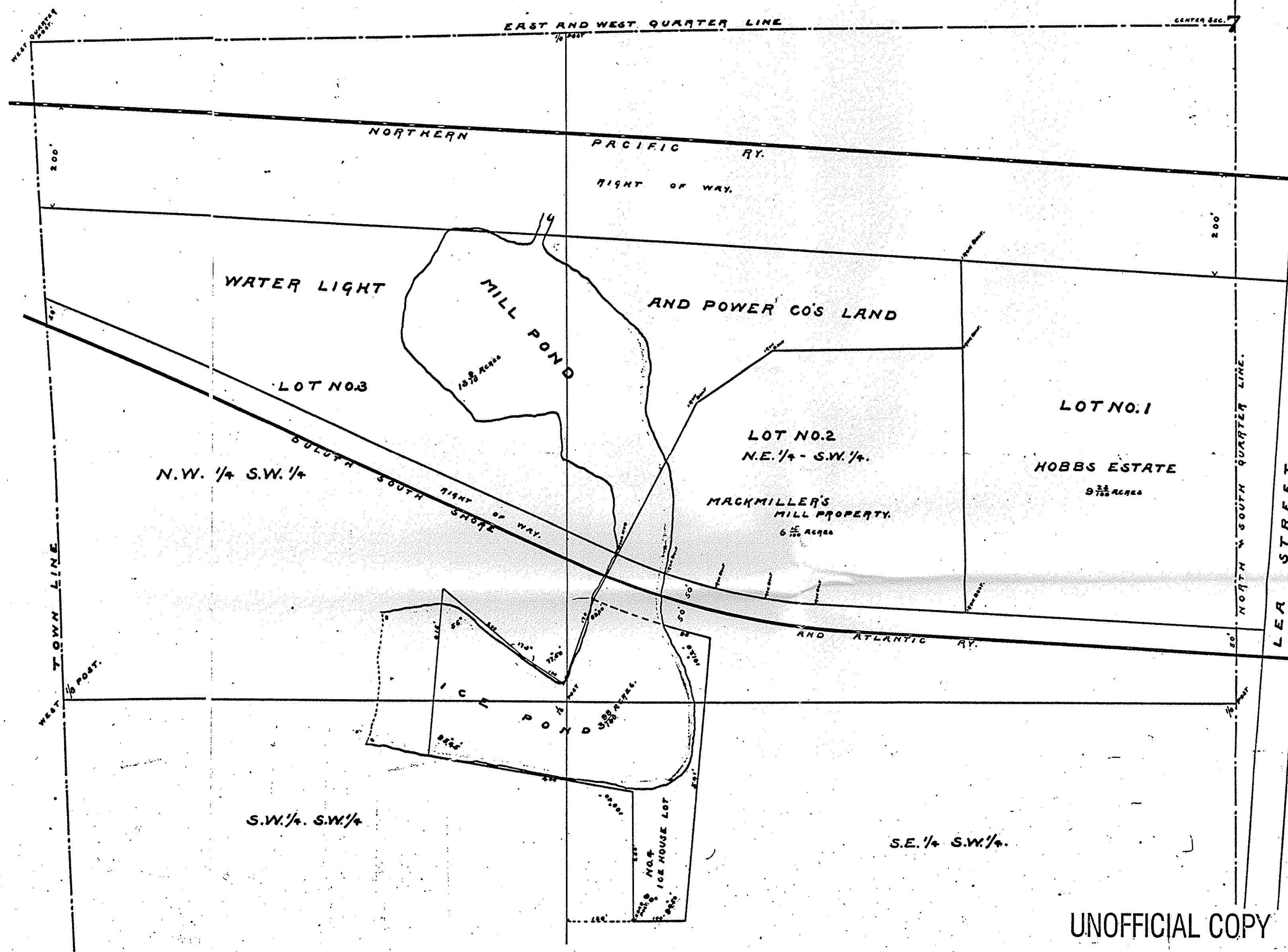

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:- That we, T. F. Mackmiller, C. S. Hobbs, and Iron River Water, Light & Power Company, a Wisconsin corporation, all of Iron River, Bayfield County, Wisconsin, severally own some one or more of the lots designated on the annexed plat, that is to say:

Said C. S. Hobbs owns lot numbered one (L.1) of said plat, and the same contains nine and twenty three one hundredths (9.23) acres; said T. F. Mackmiller owns lot numbered two (L.2) of said plat, and the same contains six and fifteen one hundredths (6.15) acres; and said T. F. Mackmiller also owns lot numbered four (L.4) of said plat and the same contains three and ninety eight one hundredths (3.98) acres; and said Iron River Water, Light & Power Company owns lot numbered three (L.3) of said plat and the same contains thirteen and nine tenths (13.9) acres.

That we caused a survey and plat of said lands to be made, so that the same might become a public record of Bayfield County, for certainty and convenience in describing said lands for assessment and taxation as well as for other purposes.
