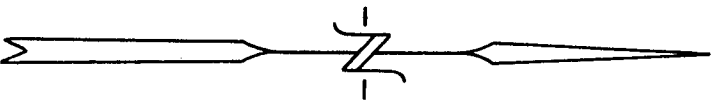

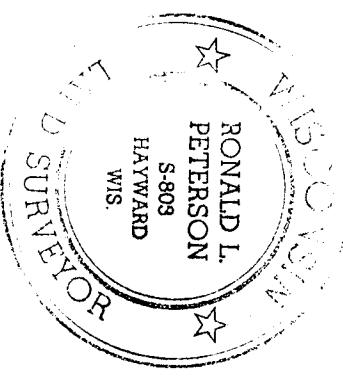

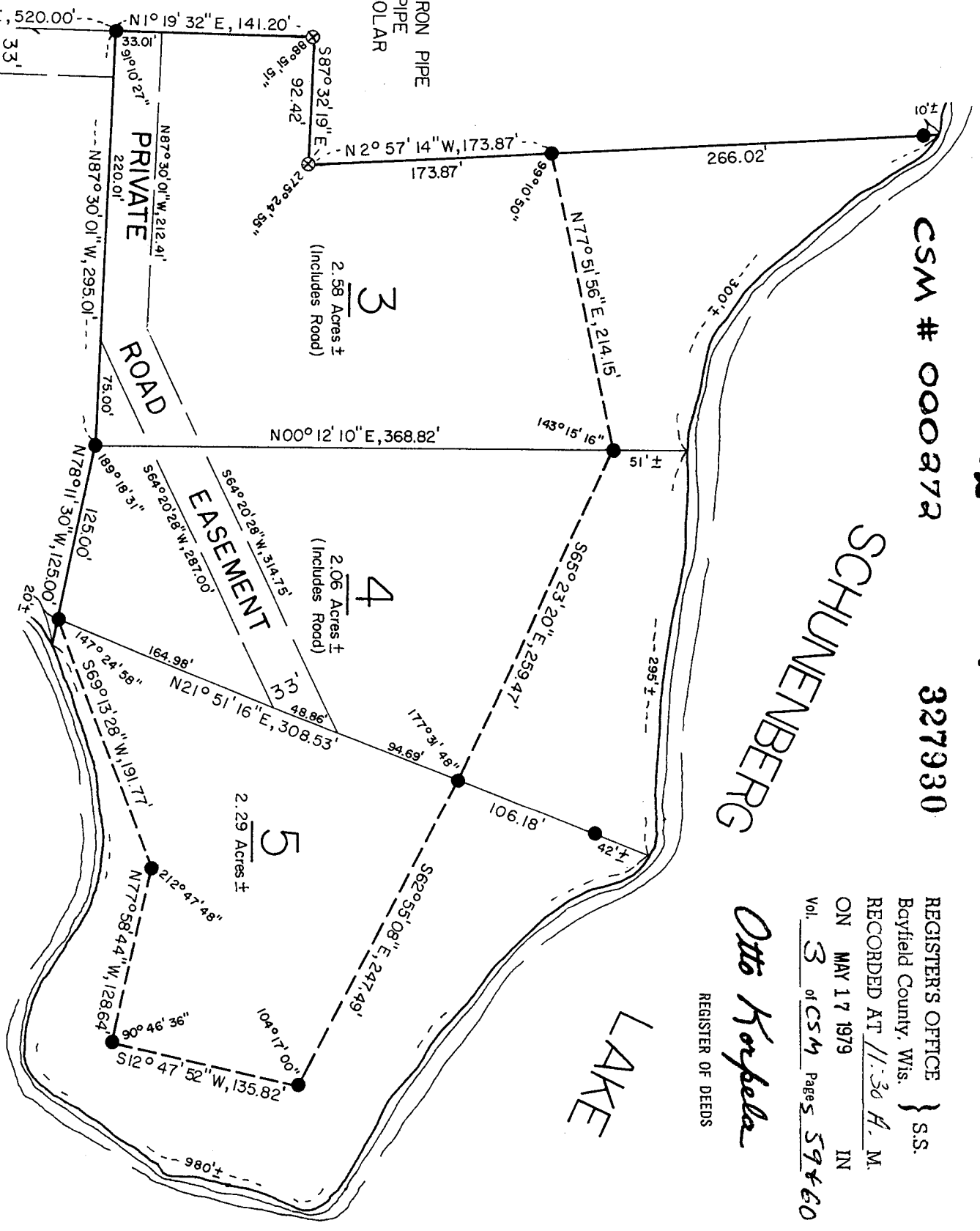

Peterson, Wisconsin Registered Land Surveyor, hereby certify that in compliance with Chapter 236:34 of the Wisconsin Statutes and under the direction of Risberg Realty, owners, I have surveyed, divided and mapped the land herein described, that said map is a correct representation of the survey made to the best of my knowledge and ability and that said land is located in the S $\frac{1}{2}$ -NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 2, T. 44 N, R.9 W. described as follows;

Commencing at the West $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 2, known as the Day-O'Brien corner, Thence S. 80° 20'31" E, 163.69 feet to the West $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 2, known as the Hall-Johnson corner, Thence S. 87° 30'01" E, 1123.17 feet, Thence N. 1° 19'32" E, 520.00 feet to the actual point of beginning, Thence continue N. 1° 19'32" E, 141.20 feet, Thence S. 87° 32'19" E, 92.42 feet, Thence N. 2° 57'14" W, 173.87 feet to a meander corner on the Southerly shore of Schunenberg Lake, Thence along the meander line of Schunenberg and Smith Lakes as follows, N. 77° 51'56" E, 214.15 feet, Thence S. 65° 23'20" E, 259.47 feet, Thence S. 62° 55'08" E, 247.49 feet, Thence S. 12° 47'52" W, 135.82 feet, Thence N. 77° 58'44" W, 128.64 feet, Thence S. 69° 13'28" W, 191.77 feet to the end of said meander line, Thence N. 78° 11'30" W, 125.00 feet, Thence N. 87° 30'01" W, 295.01 feet to the point of beginning and including all the land between the meander line and the waters edge of Schunenberg and Smith Lakes, between the parcel lines extended.
