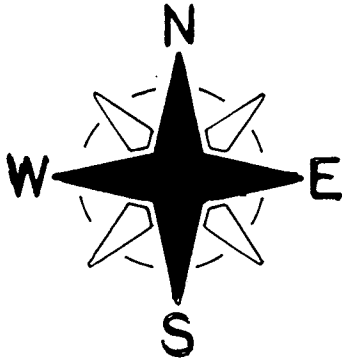

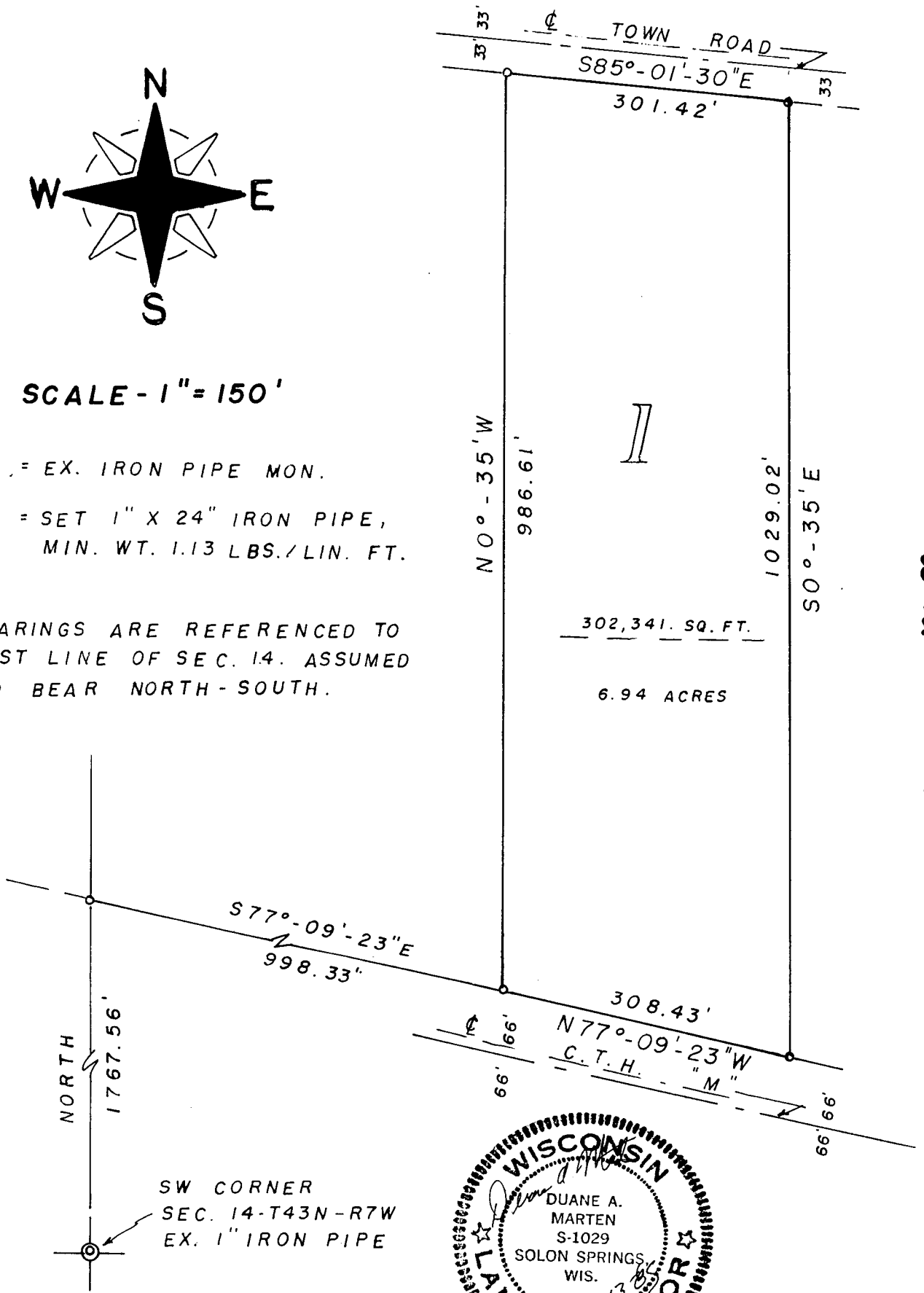
LOCATED IN THE W1/2 - SW1/4, SEC. 14 - T43N - R7W,  
TOWN OF CABLE, BAYFIELD COUNTY, WISCONSIN



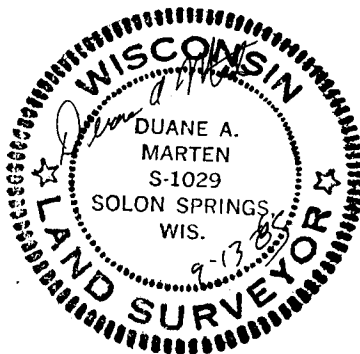

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, Duane A. Marten, Registered Land Surveyor, hereby certify:

That I have surveyed and mapped that part of the  $W\frac{1}{2}$  of the  $SW\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 14-T43N-R7W, Town of Cable, Bayfield County, Wisconsin, bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at the SW corner of said Sec. 14; thence North along the West line of the Sec., 1767.56 feet to the Northerly R/W line of C.T.H. "M"; thence  $S77^{\circ}-09'-23''E$  along said line, 998.33 feet to the point of beginning; thence  $N0^{\circ}-35'W$ , 986.61 feet to the Southerly line of a Town Road; thence  $S85^{\circ}-01'-30''E$  along said Southerly line, 301.42 feet; thence  $S0^{\circ}-35'E$ , 1029.02 feet to the Northerly line of C.T.H. "M"; thence  $N77^{\circ}-09'-23''W$  along said Northerly line, 308.43 feet to the point of beginning. Subject to all easements and reservations of record.

That such map is a correct representation of all exterior boundaries of the land surveyed and the subdivision thereof made.
