

Installing Volo View 2

Volo View 2, Volo View Express 2, and Inventor Plug-In
README

Bayfield County Land Records Note: This file is provided for your reference; it is taken from the installation guide which accompanies the software download. If you downloaded the program from the county web site, you downloaded a mirror version of Volo View Express 2, DWF-only package.

This Readme contains information about Volo™ View 2, Volo™ View Express 2, and a plug-in for viewing, marking up, and measuring Autodesk Inventor™ 5 files.

The Inventor plug-in is available on the Volo View product CD. If you downloaded Volo View 2 or Volo View Express 2, you must download the plug-in separately (<http://www.autodesk.com/volo-inventor>).

If you have downloaded the compact DWF-only package of Volo View Express, the words "DWF-only" will appear in the About box and the product can view only DWF files and load only RML markup files.

Minimum System Requirements

These requirements are the same for Volo View and Volo View Express.

-Microsoft(R) Windows(R) 98 SE, Windows 2000, Windows XP, Windows Me, or Windows NT(R) 4 Service Pack 5 or later

-Intel Pentium II (233 megahertz) or AMD K6 2 (233 megahertz)

-75 MB of free hard disk space during installation (Volo View uses 50 MB when installed)

-32 MB of RAM, 64 MB recommended

-800 x 600 SVGA video display with 256 colors (1024 x 768 or higher recommended)

-Microsoft Internet Explorer 5.01 or later

Note: Neither Volo View nor Volo View Express supports Netscape Navigator.

The DWF-only package of Volo View Express needs less than 20 MB of RAM and 20 MB of free hard drive space.

How to Obtain the Products

Bayfield County Land Records Note: You can download the DWF-only version of Volo View Express directly from our web site. You may also download other versions of the program as described below.

Volo View -- Full Installation or Upgrade: Download or obtain a CD from <http://www.autodesk.com/estore>, or obtain a CD from an authorized Autodesk reseller or distributor.

Volo View Express -- Full Installation: Download from the Product Center on the Autodesk website (<http://www.autodesk.com>).

Plug-in for Autodesk Inventor Files -- Download from <http://www.autodesk.com/volo-inventor>. Make sure to download the plug-in that applies to Volo View 2 and Volo View Express 2. Note: You do not need to download this plug-in if you have ordered a CD version of Volo View. The Inventor plug-in is included on the Volo View product CD.

Warning: If you download Volo View, Volo View Express, or the Inventor plug-in, in the File Download dialog box, choose the Save This Program to Disk option and specify a secure folder. You may need the downloaded program later to change installation options and for silent installations.

Before You Install

Before installing Volo View, Volo View Express, or the Inventor plug-in, be sure to uninstall existing versions of Volo View, Volo View Express, the Inventor plug-in, and Stand Alone Design Tracking (also called Design Assistant). For instructions, see "Uninstalling Volo View, Volo View Express, and the Inventor Plug-In" below.

Installing Downloaded Versions

If you downloaded Volo View, the Volo View upgrade, Volo View Express, Volo View Express for DWF-only, or the Inventor plug-in, follow the instructions in this section to install the product.

To install Volo View or Volo View Express

1. Close all applications.
2. Double-click the setup program that you downloaded, and follow the on-screen instructions.

Note for Windows 98 SE and Windows NT users: If you are prompted to reboot the computer, after the reboot an error message might be displayed. Choose OK in the error message box, and then double-click the setup program that you downloaded. Follow the on-screen instructions.

3. To install the Inventor plug-in, see "To install the Inventor plug-in" below.
4. If the operating system on the computer is Windows 98 or Windows Me, you must restart the computer for Volo View or Volo View Express to work correctly.

Silent Installation on Multiple Computers

With the silent installation option, you can install a product without displaying a user interface during the installation. A silent installation is often used for installations on multiple computers, although the program you are installing must be installed separately on each.

To use a silent installation with Volo View Express

1. Close all applications.
2. Open a DOS command window.
3. In the command window, change to the directory containing the appropriate setup program.
4. Enter a command using the following syntax. The command will vary depending on the installation options you choose, as described below. The command cannot contain line breaks.

```
vve2setup.exe -a /* -I*v %TEMP%\VVEInstall.log -i voloviewexpress.msi  
/qb  
INSTALLDIR="c:\Program Files\Volo View Express"  
ACAD_SILENT_LICENSE=YES
```

5. Restart the computer.

The parts of the installation command are as follows:

* vve2setup.exe -a /* -l*v %TEMP%\VVEInstall.log -i voloviewexpress.msi -- Runs the silent installation using voloviewexpress.msi and creates a log file named VVEInstall.log; do not use subdirectory names before the name of the log file.

Alternatives include the following:

/x <full path and MSI name> -- Uninstalls a program.

* /qb -- Displays a basic user interface only.

* INSTALLDIR -- Location where the program is installed; enclose in quotes if the location name contains spaces.

* ACAD_SILENT_LICENSE -- License agreement for the program you are installing.

Installation Limitations

-If installing or uninstalling a product such as AutoCAD(R) changes Volo View or Volo View Express functionality, you might need to repair the installation. If you downloaded the setup program, double-click the program you downloaded. In the Application Maintenance dialog box, choose Repair, and then click Next to begin the repair. If you have a product CD, follow the same procedure, but use the setup program on the CD.

-If uninstalling Volo View or Volo View Express changes AutoCAD functionality, you can use the Repair option in the AutoCAD setup program. Double-click the setup program. In the Application Maintenance dialog box, choose Repair, and then click Next to begin the repair.

-If you need to add or remove components, or reinstall, use the setup program you used for installation. If you downloaded the setup program, double-click the program you downloaded. In the Application Maintenance dialog box, choose Repair to reinstall, or choose Modify to add or remove components. Then click Next. If you have a product CD, follow the same procedure, but use the setup program on the CD.

-If you are prompted to reboot the computer before installation can begin, you may need to manually restart the setup program by double-clicking it.

Uninstalling Volo View, Volo View Express, and the Inventor Plug-In

To uninstall Volo View, Volo View Express, or the Inventor plug-in

1. From the Windows Start menu, choose Settings. Then choose Control Panel.
2. In the Control Panel, double-click Add/Remove Programs.
3. In the Add/Remove Programs dialog box, select the appropriate program.
4. Follow the on-screen instructions.

General Limitations

-If using the Zoom or Orbit option causes parts of a drawing to disappear from the screen, choose Refit from the View menu to redisplay the objects.

-Volo View and Volo View Express cannot open files on File Transfer Protocol (FTP) sites that require a secure password (a non-anonymous login).

-On Windows NT 4, the context-sensitive Help may not work correctly in the Customize dialog box.

-If Volo View or Volo View Express is running on a computer that has AutoCAD installed, hyperlinks may work incorrectly, and you may be unable to open RML files from Windows(R) Explorer.

-If you try to open an Inventor file that is already open, you may see an error stating that the file is invalid. You can open the file once it has been closed.

-Volo View and Volo View Express display DWG, DXF, and DWF files in a web page. However, to print a web page using the Print option on the File menu (instead of using the shortcut menu), you must use Internet Explorer 5.5.
