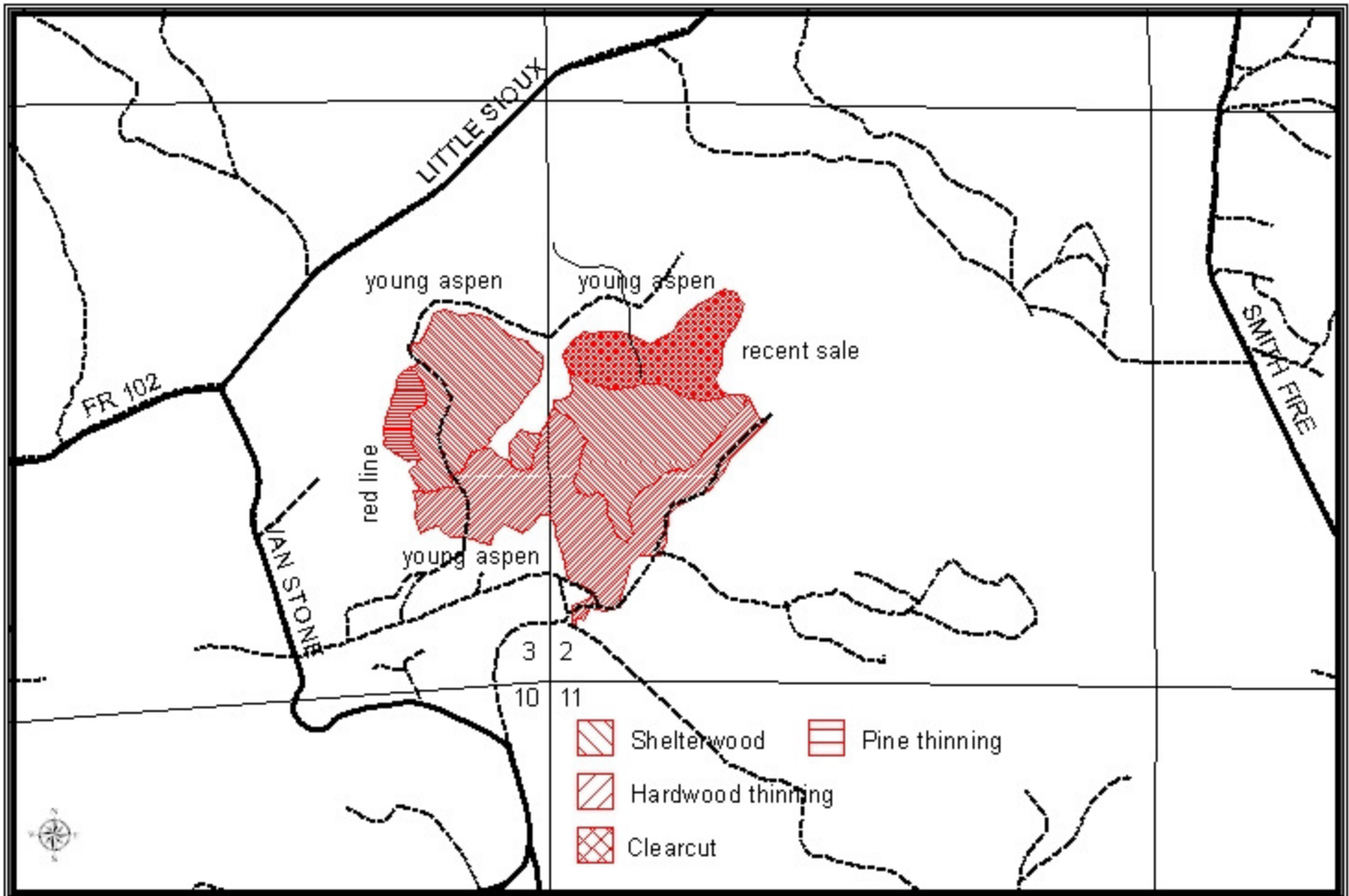

## Harvest Requirements:

- Scaled sale
- Sale borders younger aspen and a recent sale. There is red line between units and on portions of the borders of the sale
- Utilize hardwood to a 5 inch top and softwood to a 4 inch top
- Harvest balsam and spruce with a 4 inch dbh or greater thru entire sale
- Harvest all jack pine throughout entire sale
- Do not harvest hemlock
- Harvest all aspen and non-green marked white birch thru entire sale
- Clearcut unit: Harvest all merchantable stems except pine, sever all non-merchantable stems 2" in diameter and greater
- Shelterwood unit: Harvest all stems except green marked trees and pine, sever all non-merchantable stems 2" in diameter and greater. No sale operations allowed between breakup and Sept. 1st.
- Hardwood unit: harvest all orange marked trees along with all trees within canopy gaps, which are marked out in green paint. Within canopy gaps knock down or sever all stems 1" or greater at dbh
- Pine thinning unit: harvest all green marked pine along
- No sale operations permitted between breakup and July 15th in hardwood unit
- Damage to residual trees will not be tolerated
- There is a steep hill that is located in the southeast part of the sale that is included within the sale. Loggers are expected to harvest as much as they can on this hill.
