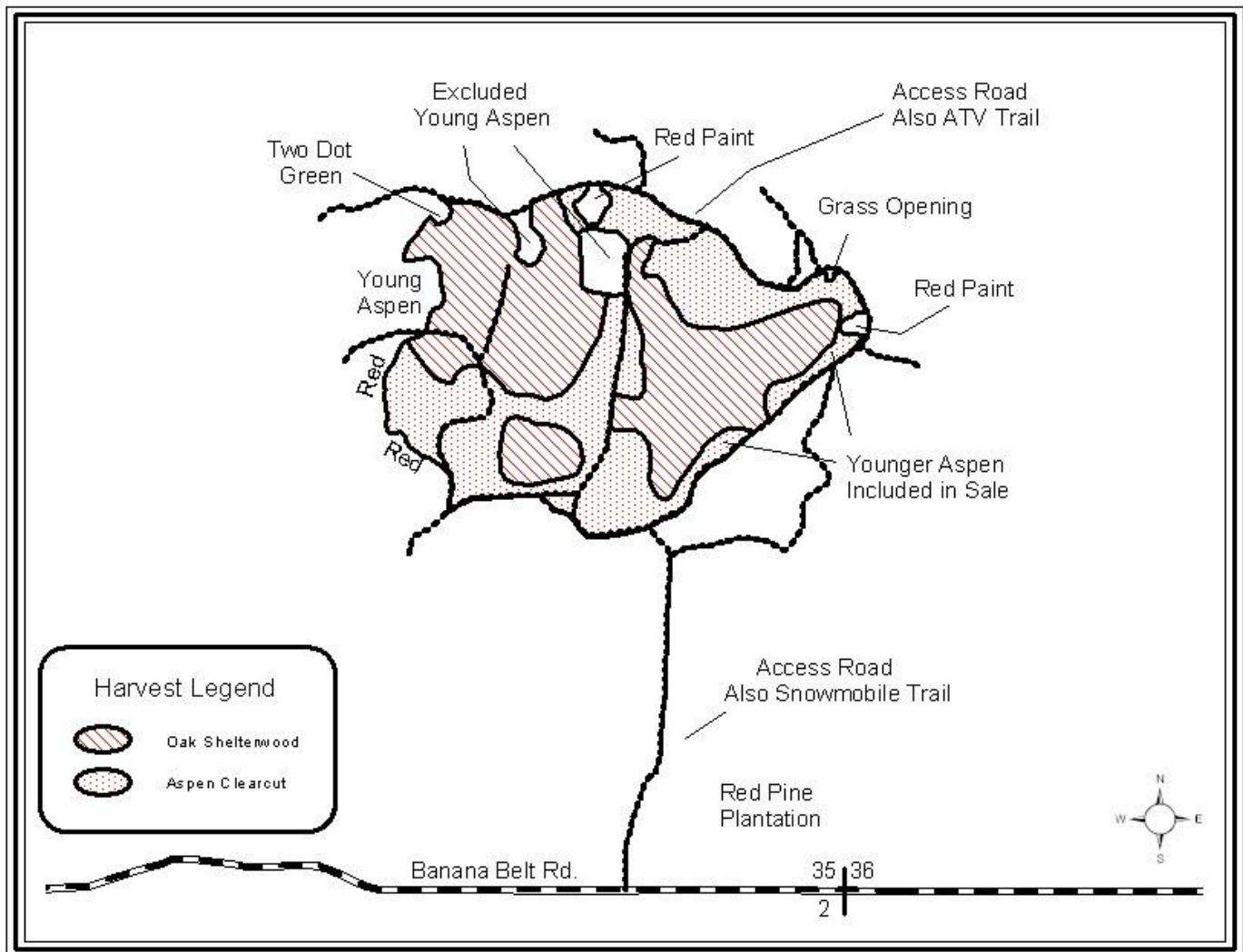

Harvest Requirements:

This will be a TICKET SCALE sale. Existing trail surrounds a majority of this sale and is the boundary. Occasional red paint was placed along the trail for reference. Two dot green paint designates the sale boundary when natural features are not as obvious. Red paint is the boundary as shown on the map. Throughout the sale area, harvest all hardwood trees 2" dbh and larger NOT marked with green paint. There is no boundary line separating the red oak shelterwood areas from the clearcut areas. The shelterwood areas contain green painted leave trees. The last green painted tree is considered the boundary. RESTRICTIONS: In the red oak shelterwood, harvesting will be allowed between August 1st and snow cover (as determined by the sale administrator). This is to avoid potential conflict with snowmobile traffic. Do not harvest any conifers. In the clearcut areas, no harvesting will be allowed between snow cover and spring break up (as determined by the sale administrator). Do not harvest any conifers. Younger aspen can be found along portions of the trail. These areas are to be harvested as part of the sale. Two stands of younger, smaller diameter aspen are located in the northern end of the sale. These areas are excluded from harvest. There is no paint around these exclusion areas. This contract requires County authorization for all road and landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure (refer to section 17). Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County. The entire northern boundary is an existing atv trail. All necessary precautions must be taken to ensure safe working conditions.
