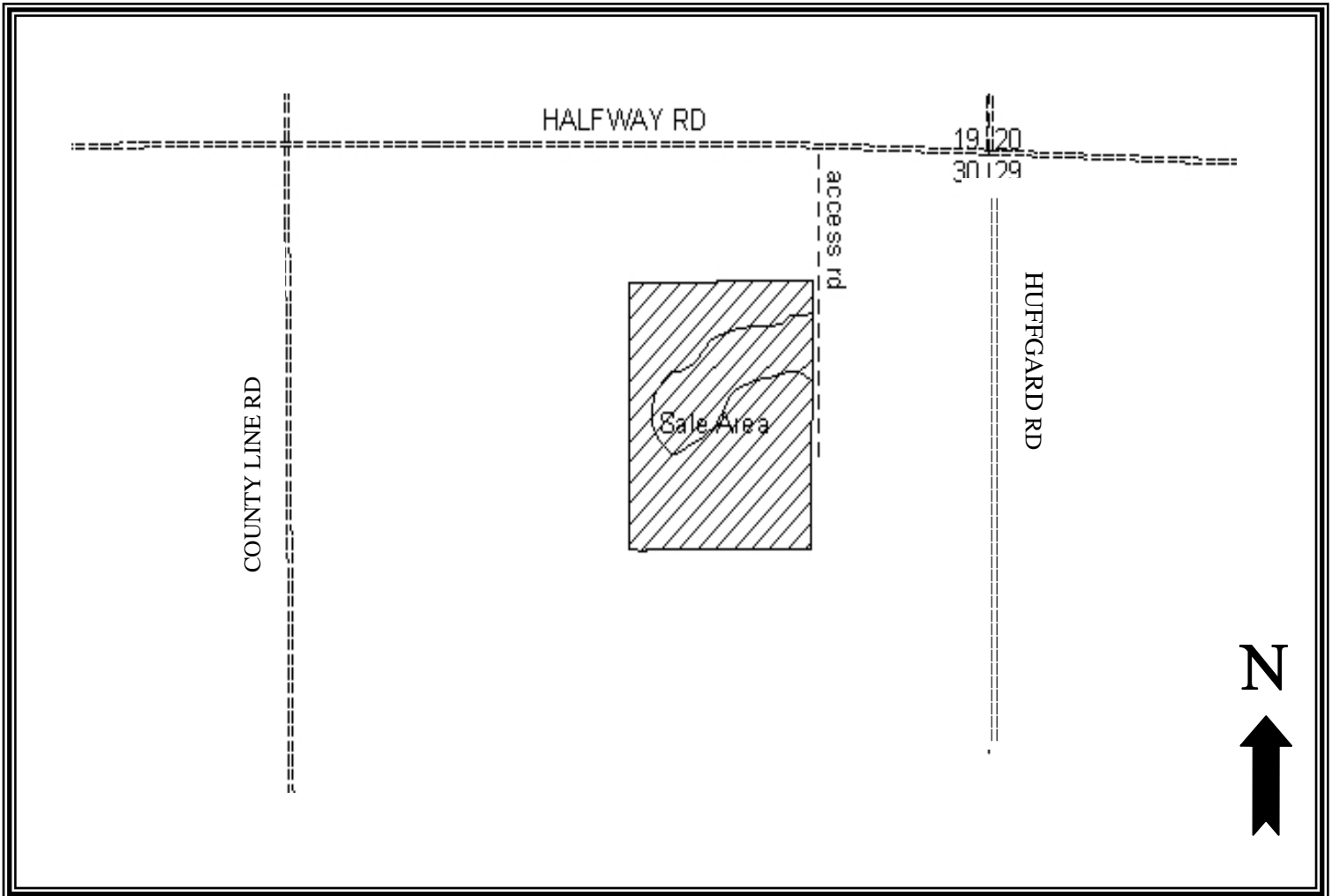

Harvest requirements: Cut all trees within the sale area. Sever or drive over all stems 1 inch or larger. The sale boundary is obvious with seedlings and saplings surrounding. The 12 acre portion within the plantation is younger and more open grown. This contract requires County approval for all road/landing construction. Decking of wood along Town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield Co. Do not damage survey monuments. All pine must be hauled within three weeks of harvest between May 1st and September 1st. This is a ticket scale sale.
