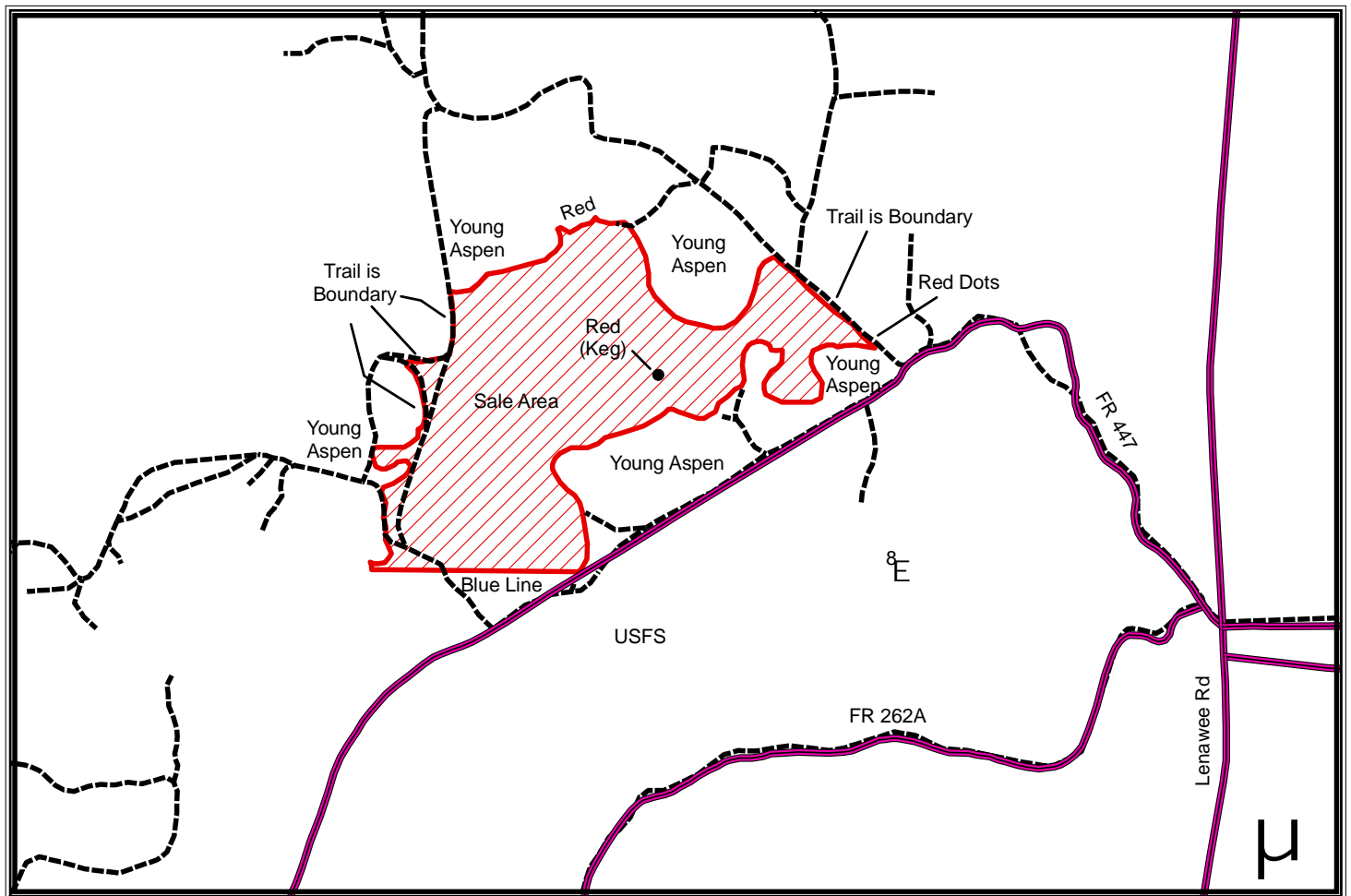

Harvest Requirements:

- > This is a Ticket Scale Sale.
- > Young aspen surrounds most of the sale area and is the boundary.
- > The trails are the boundary as indicated on the map. Occasional red paint is placed along the trail for guidance.
- > Blue line is the southern boundary and red line is the northern most boundary.
- > Red line surrounds a small keg near the middle of the sale. No equipment or felled trees are allowed to cross the red line.
- > Harvest all hardwoods 2" dbh and larger within the sale area.
- > Do not harvest any conifers.
- > This contract requires County authorization for all road and landing construction and places other requirements on road construction and closure (refer to Section 17).
- > Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
- > Do not damage any survey or boundary monumentation.
- > The access road into the sale and the eastern most trail are ATV routes. Use extra caution when operating on or near these trails.
