PERMIT FOR SAND, GRAVEL, AND MATERIALS
REMOVED FROM BAYFIELD COUNTY LANDS

Permission is hereby granted to _____
for the purpose of removing _____ from _____

Bayfield County, WI, at the rate of _____
Being under the direction of the Bayfield County Forest Administrator in accordance with
the following regulations as set forth by the Bayfield County Forestry Committee:

1. Bayfield County, or its agents, accept no responsibility for accidents of any nature whatsoever which may occur on said properties as a result of operations of said permittee.
2. Material removal operations must be carried out in a manner consistent with Bayfield County Forest aims and uses. If needed, the Forest Administrator shall regulate access locations, garbage disposal, culvert locations and other such necessary items.
3. No section corners, monuments or bearing trees will be removed or destroyed by permittee.
4. Any timber removed or damaged in operation of permit will be paid for, by the permittee, at the going stumpage rate.
5. No windrowing of timber, brush or other materials will be allowed in pit or on adjacent lands.
6. No test holes or drilling will be allowed except by permit and such test holes or drilling will be filled in by permittee within ten days.
7. No pits can be enlarged by permittee without permission of Forest Administrator.
8. All pits will be maintained so as to allow the maximum utilization of materials.
9. Non-mineral screenings, from crusher operations, will be removed from pit by permittee.
10. All permits shall be for a specific period of time or for specified yardages of materials.
11. Reports of total yardage of gravel, sand, rock, etc., removed from pit will be forwarded to the Forestry Department upon termination of permit or as directed by the Forest Administrator.
12. Final payment will be made on actual yardage at termination of permit. Partial payments shall be made if directed by Forest Administrator.
13. No equipment will remain on site after termination of permit. All litter and debris left at side of operation must be hauled away to an authorized site.
14. Upon completion of permit, if it is necessary, the pit shall be back-sloped by permittee.
15. Any violation of these regulations will be deemed a trespass and shall be grounds for the refusal to grant future permits to persons violation such regulations. The rate charged for a trespass shall be left to the discretion of the Forest Administrator.
