2000 OBJECTIVE AND POLICY

OBJECTIVE

To develop an annual work plan that will achieve the objectives set forth in this plan to the greatest extent feasible, consistent with program priorities established in the Mission Statement and within the budget direction established by the County Board.

POLICY

The County Forest will be sustainably managed at a level of operation that considers the health of the forest and the products and amenities desired by the public in accordance with the goals identified in Chapter 100.

2100 ANNUAL WORK PLAN AND BUDGET

Each year an Annual Work Plan shall be prepared by the Forest Administrator with assistance from the DNR liaison forester. The annual work plan shall set the yearly direction for implementing this Comprehensive Land Use Plan. Annual work plans are submitted through the Forestry Committee to be approved by the County Board and forwarded to the DNR as required by Wisconsin statutes s. 28.11(5)(b) and s.28.11(5m)(b). Following County Board approval, a copy is provided to official copy-holders of the *County Forest Comprehensive Land Use Plan* for inclusion as an amendment to this chapter. The County Forest budget is prepared in coordination with the County Administrator and presented to the County Board for approval as part of the over-all county budget process.

The Annual Work Plan will include proposed activities such as;

- 1 Acres of harvest areas to prepare for sale, by species.
- 2 Reforestation targets
- 3 Wildlife and fisheries projects
- 4 Road and trail plans
- 5 Forest inventory goals
- 6 Other activities

Annual Work Plans will be included in this chapter after they have been approved by the County Board.
