

**MINUTES OF THE BAYFIELD COUNTY HIGHWAY COMMITTEE  
WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 8, 2010**

The regular meeting of the Bayfield County Highway Committee was called to order by Chairman Bichanich at 4:00 PM on Wednesday December 8, 2010 at the Highway Office in Washburn. Present were Committee members: Bennett, Crandall, Maki and Williams, Patrol Superintendent Johanik and Commissioner Toepfer.

Motion by Crandall / Williams and carried to approve the minutes of the November 10, 2010 meeting of the Bayfield County Highway Committee.

The next meeting was scheduled for January 12, 2011.

Pitlik and Wick representatives, George Lurvey and Brad Pitlik joined the meeting and gave an informational presentation on foamed asphalt base stabilization. The process strengthens an existing road base by mixing hot foamed asphalt with the pulverized road thereby reducing the need for additional CABC (gravel) and minimizing raising the profile of the road. The Commissioner reported that the process may be a viable alternative for use during the resurfacing on CTH D.

Vouchers were audited. After discussion, motion by Crandall / Bennett and carried to approve vouchers totaling \$241,081.04.

The Commissioner presented an amended Sec 10-1-10 Speed Limits (attached) eliminating the section of 45 mph on CTH C between Big Rock Road and west 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Motion by Maki / Crandall and carried to present the amendment as an ordinance to the full County Board.

The Commissioner presented an amendment to Article 32 of the labor agreement with the Teamsters Local 346 providing for a \$40 reimbursement to the employee for the purchase of insulated coveralls rather than a participating vendor. Motion by Crandall / Bennett and carried to approve the amendment for presentation to personnel and the full County Board.

The Commissioner reported on the 2011 Winter Highway Conference in January.

The Commissioner reported that the department sold pickup #90 by sealed bid for \$754.00.

The Commissioner reported that he has returned a State / Municipal Agreement encumbering a \$1.4 M earmark for the resurfacing of CTH C from North Boundary to FR 252.

The Committee adjourned at 6:30 PM.
