2010 Bayfield County Fair Official Karaoke Rules

1. Relatives or employer/employees of the DJ and/or Judges are not eligible to participate.
2. Only amateur singers will be allowed
3. Must either be wearing a Thursday Daily Wristband or Season Pass Wristband if over the age of 4.
4. Two Age Divisions: 17 and Older - 16 and Younger
5. A parent/guardian must register all singers 17 and younger. A parent/guardian must be present with any contestant under the age of 17.
6. Registration will be done at the Fair.
 - a. Junior Division should register between 6:00 & 6:30 pm. Senior Division should register between 6:30 pm & 7 pm.
 - b. Contestants are not allowed to bring their own discs. Singers must sing songs from the DJ's library (the DJ carries a multitude of songs - over 10,000 titles. Contestant must specify the songs you are going to sing when you sign up.
7. Singers will sing in order registered.
8. Only one singer will be judged at a time.
9. NO profanity will be allowed at any time. (If this happens, the microphone power will be disconnected and the singer will be disqualified.)
10. Contestants will sing two songs. It will be up to the judges if more songs need to be sung.
11. Singer's names will be called to keep two (2) on standby at all times. Any singer not at the stage when it is their time to sing will be disqualified.
12. This is a family show, appropriate dress must be adhered to while on stage.
13. No food, drink or smoking is allowed on stage.
14. Equipment malfunction gives the contestant a chance to start over
15. Any contestant guilty of distracting any of the other contestants while they are performing shall be disqualified
16. Any contestant guilty of insulting or starting any confrontation with any of the audience or other contestant will be disqualified
17. Any contestant guilty of damaging the equipment will be disqualified.

18. Release of pictures/media taken at the Karaoke Contest:
 - a. By entering the Karaoke Contest, the contestant or parent/legal guardian of the minor contestant, hereafter referred to as "You", hereby give the Bayfield County Fair the absolute right and permission to use photographic pictures and/or video of you, in whole or in part, or composite or distorted on character or form, in conjunction with your own or a fictitious name, or reproductions thereof in color, or otherwise, made through any media at our venue or elsewhere, for art, advertising, trade or any other lawful purpose whatever.
 - b. You hereby waive any right that you may have to inspect and/or approve the finished product or advertising copy that may be used in connection therewith, or the use in which it may be applied.
 - c. You, hereby release, discharge, and agree to save the Bayfield County Fair any liability by virtue of any blurring, distortion, alteration, optical illusion, or use in composite form, whether intentional or otherwise, that may occur or be produced in the taking of the said pictures, or in any processing tending toward the completion of the finished product.
19. Scoring will be based on vocal ability, song difficulty, stage presence and Judges preference
20. **ALL Decisions of the Judges will be final!**
