

Guide Lines for Bayfield County Veteran Transportation Program

This program is funded by the Bayfield County taxpayers and grants by the Wisconsin Department of Veteran's Affairs. It is administered on a daily basis by the County Veterans Service Office, to provide transportation for Veteran's medical appointments at VA medical facilities or VA contracted facilities. We provide transportation or mileage to the Twin Ports Outpatient Clinic, Superior, WI, the VET Center Duluth, MN and to the VAMC Minneapolis vans (The DAV and the Douglas County Van out of Superior, WI and the Sawyer County Van out of Hayward, WI). This service is for routine medical attention and is not for emergencies. If your medical condition requires immediate medical attention dial 911.

For use of the Volunteer Drivers Program the veteran must qualify by the following reasons:

Veteran must be enrolled in the VA Health Care System

- Veteran is disabled so as not to be able to drive under the conditions to make their appointment
- Or Veteran meets low income levels and has no means of providing their own transportation.

For uses of the programs mileage reimbursement

Veteran must be enrolled in the VA Health Care System

- Veteran is over 65 years of age
- Or 0-20% Service connected Veterans
- Or Low income Veterans less than NSC Pension levels

*Certain Veterans not eligible for reimbursement due to their ability to make mileage claims from the VA.

- (30-100 %) Service Connected Veteran
- Veterans on NSC Pension

*If (30-100 %) Service Connected Veteran Veterans or NSC Pension Veterans are not qualified for re-imburement from the VA they may request special consideration to the Veteran Service Officer
