

Article E: System Management and Maintenance

Sec. 15-1-18 Maintenance Program.

- (a) Maintenance agreements for all POWTS using a soil absorption component shall be recorded with the Bayfield County Register of Deeds prior to the issuance of a sanitary permit. ((A)10/26/2010)
- (b) The applicant for a sanitary permit shall be provided written notice of the maintenance program at the time the sanitary permit is issued. ((A)10/26/2010)
- (c) The maintenance and servicing of all POWTS in Bayfield County shall occur as required by Comm. 83.54 Wis. Adm. Code and Sec. 145.245 Wis. Stats. ((A)10/26/2010)
- (d) The reporting of the inspection, maintenance and servicing event shall be specified by the County and shall include the minimum requirements of Comm. 83.55 Wis. Adm. Code. ((A)10/26/2010)

Sec. 15-1-19 Holding Tank Maintenance Agreement.

- (a) A holding tank agreement shall be recorded with the deed for the property as required by Comm. 83.21(2)(c)5 Wis. Adm. Code.
- (b) The owner or agent shall submit the original copy of the holding tank Maintenance Agreement when plans are submitted to the County for review.
- (c) The owner of a holding tank may be placed on a three (3)-year maximum inspection cycle. The inspection report shall be submitted to the County within 30 calendar days from the date of inspection.

The inspection required shall be performed by one of the following:

- a. A licensed master plumber.
- b. A licensed master plumber–restricted service.
- c. A certified POWTS inspector.
- d. A certified septage servicing operator under ch. NR 114.
- e. A registered POWTS maintainer.
