The pumper's have a User Name and a Password to access the County program. They receive this service **free of charge** from the Bayfield County Planning and Zoning Dept. The pumper is responsible to locate the property by the parcel number or tracking number on the yellow postcard. They enter into the system the day they were at the property, how much they pumped out, who they are, and where they disposed of it.

Property Owners can check to see if their pumper reported the pumping. Go on-line to:

Find Pull Down Box: 1st Box--click on Wisconsin; 2nd box click on Bayfield

Go to Property Search (i.e. magnify glass): Click on it

Find Select a Search Method: Enter your Parcel Number (found on the front of your postcard)
