Motion by Milanowski / Oswald and carried to approve the minutes of the December 4, 2019 meeting.

ATV Route application – Town of Washburn requesting ATV route from Avol-Law Residence to South Maple Hill Road (.6 miles). Motion by Milanowski / Oswald to send to the full board for approval.

Public Input: Royden Bloom and Mark Jerome requested an agreement with Bayfield County to share in the liability and maintenance of the dam at US 63/Drummond, which the DOT can no longer own. The Commissioner referred them to the Land & Water Conservation Department.

Vouchers were audited. A motion by Milanowski / Fickbohm and carried to approve the vouchers as presented totaling \$731,160.70 (2019) and \$73,788.73 (2020).
