Motion by Maki / Milanowski and carried to approve the minutes of the July 2, 2019 meeting.

Public Input: Discussion regarding ATV routes.

Rick Cuthman, Elk Country ATV Club from Town of Namakagon regarding 50-70' connector from Old Grade Rd to County Line. Highway Department didn't receive request from Town of Namakagon. This segment will be discussed at September meeting.

Discussion from Jack Olson, a resident from the Town of Washburn in favor of opening up the ATV route on CTH C from Big Rock Road to McKinley Road. Also present were Town of Bayview residents in favor of opening up this same route.

Motion by Maki / Milanowski and carried to approve ATV Route CTH C – Big Rock Road to McKinley Road – one mile segment after much discussion. Motion carried to go to full board.

Motion by Maki / Milanowski and carried to approve ATV Route on CTH D – Triangle Drive to Pioneer Road – one mile.

Paul Johanik, Highway Commission commented that Douglas County is writing up ordinance to open up all roads to ATV/UTV's.

Discussion regarding signing on CTH J to the discretion of the Highway Commissioner.

Discussion regarding CTH D posted as Class B Road. Paul Johanik, Highway Commissioner wants to keep as Class B, which is the same as Town of Namakagon.

Vouchers were audited. A motion by Milanowski / Maki and carried to approve the vouchers as presented totaling \$472,858.23.

Discussion on financial reports.


Commissioner Reports:
