

Harvest Requirements:

- > This sale is being sold on a Ticket Scale Basis.
- > The sale boundaries are marked in red paint
- > Prescription: LEAVE all red pine, white pine, white cedar, hemlock and purple painted trees. HARVEST all other merchantable hardwoods and merchantable balsam and spruce. SEVER all non-merchantable hardwood stems 2" in diameter and greater except leave all oak 4" dbh and smaller.
- ➤ 1 in 10 tops less than 4" dbh must be left scattered across the site
- > Harvesting may only occur during frozen or dry ground conditions. Harvesting may not occur before September 1<sup>st</sup>.
- > During winter harvesting the snowmobile trail must be kept unobstructed and in a packed snow condition. The purchaser must insure that harvesting and hauling operations will not create a safety hazard to snowmobiles.
- Leave all snags except individuals that pose a safety hazard
- > Do not damage any survey monuments.
- > To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces of the logging equipment.
- > This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure. (refer to Sec. 17)
