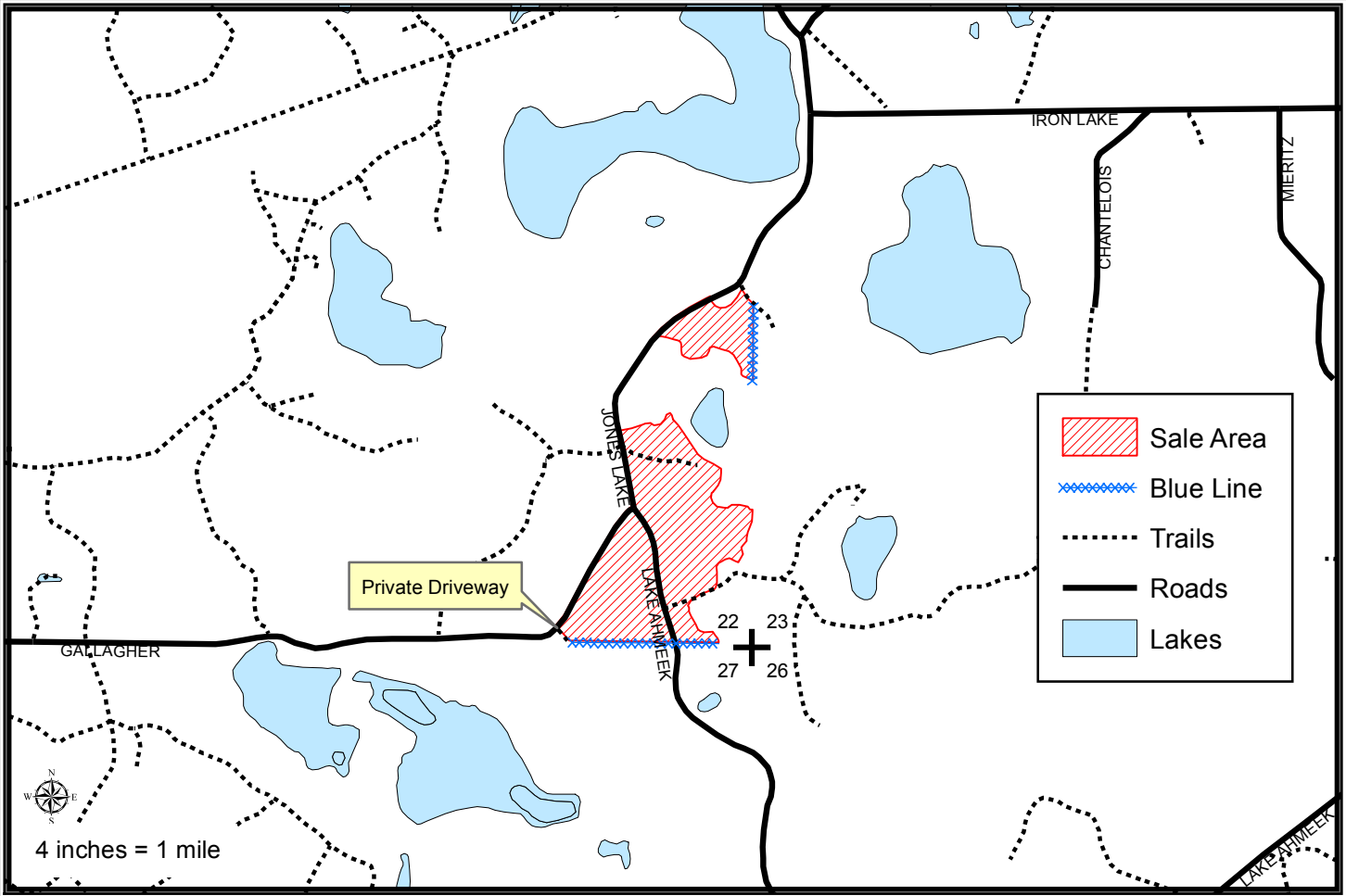

Harvest Requirements:

- Sale is an overstory removal being sold on a Ticket Scale Basis.
- Harvest all merchantable hardwood.
- Leave all purple marked trees. Leave all conifer. Leave all oak under 6" DBH.
- If the whole tree is utilized 1 in 10 tops less than or equal to 4" in diameter must be left scattered across the site.
- Damage to existing regeneration must be minimized.
- Sale boundaries are painted red line and blue line. The southwestern line is a private driveway. Do not cross driveway or fell trees across the driveway. Driveway shall not be used for access.
- Do not cut snags except for those that pose a safety hazard.
- Do not damage any survey monumentation.
- To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
