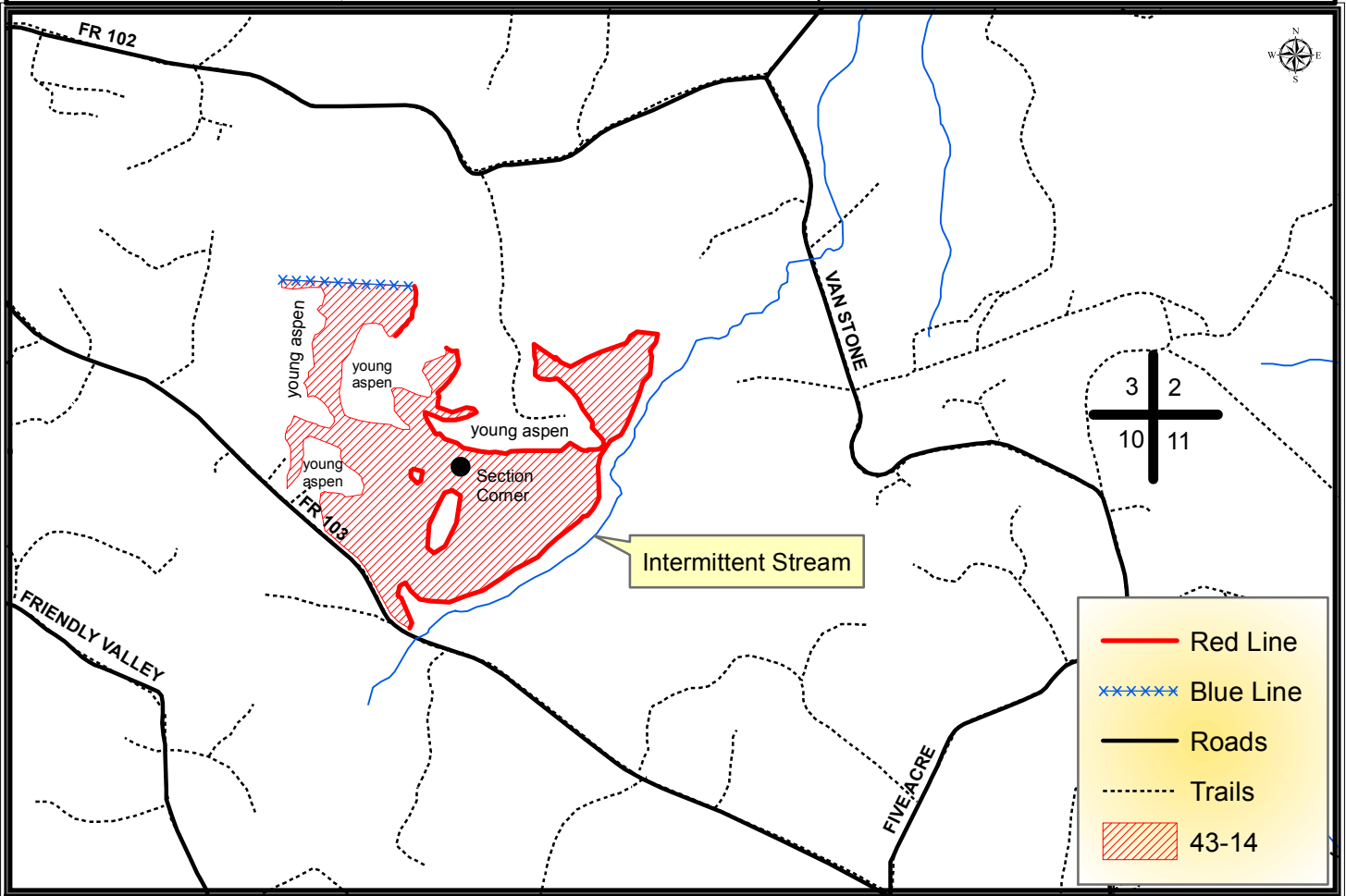

Harvest Requirements:

1 inch = 0.25 miles

- Sale is a red oak seed tree being sold on a ticket scale basis.
- Sale boundaries consist of abrupt timber type change (young aspen), red paint line, blue paint line and FR 103.
- **Harvest all merchantable hardwood except purple marked trees. Harvest all purple marked red pine and white pine. Harvest all Jack pine, Balsam fir and Spruce**
- Leave all unmarked red and white pine and all purple marked hardwood (including aspen) species. Sever all hardwood stems 2" in diameter and greater.
- Minimize damage to residual stand. Do not damage any survey monuments.
- The blue line indicates private property. No equipment or felled trees may cross the line.
- Do not cut snags except for those that pose a safety hazard.
- Whole tree harvesting and/or utilization of tops less than 4" diameter will not be allowed.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
- To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
