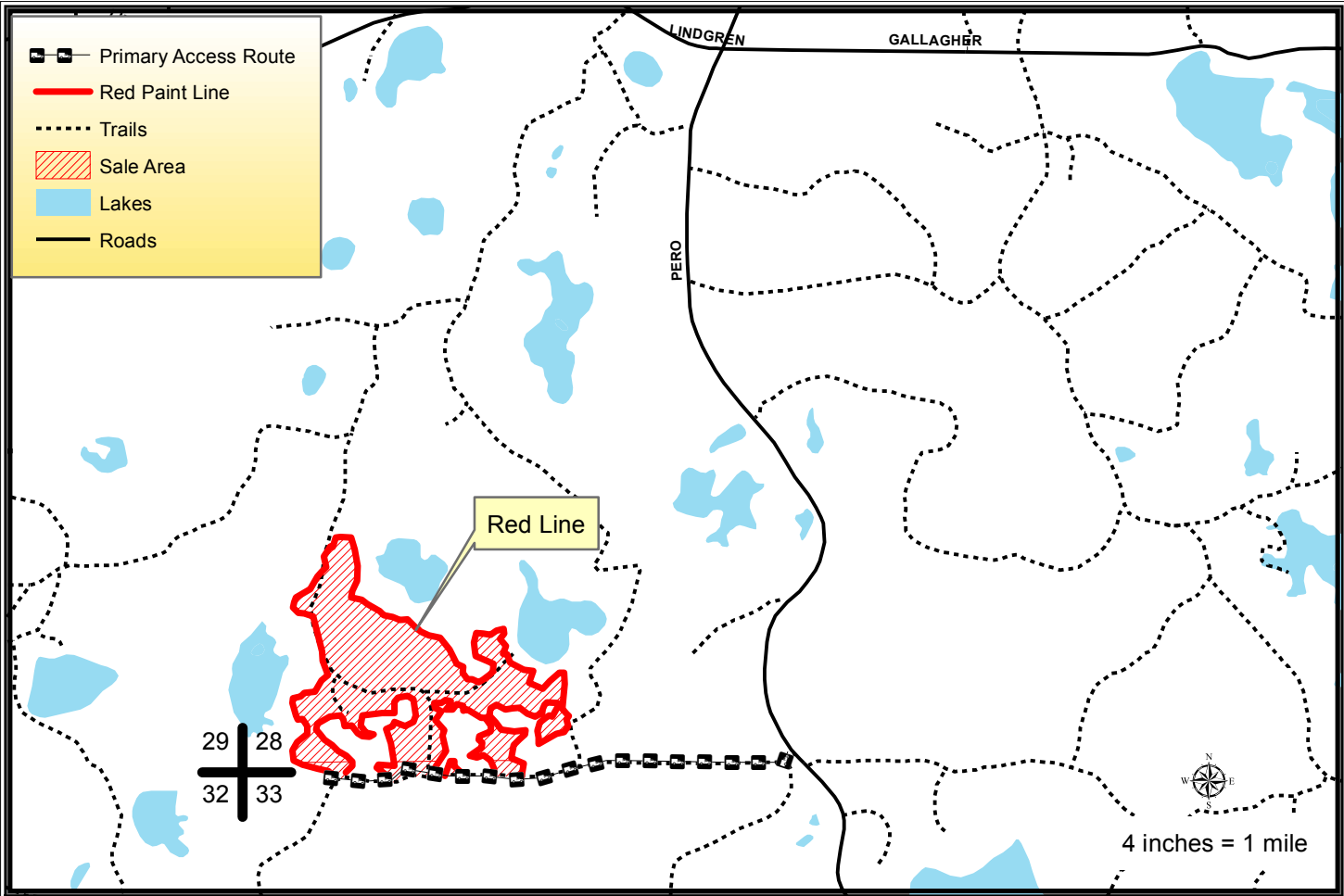

Harvest Requirements:

- Sale is an oak seed tree being sold on a Ticket Scale Basis.
- Sale boundaries are painted redline or existing logging roads.
- Harvest all merchantable timber. Do not harvest any purple-marked oak or purple-marked white birch. Do not harvest any balsam fir, spruce, white pine or yellow birch.
- Sever all hardwood stems 2 inches and greater.
- Contractor will be required to install 3 culverts on the access road.
- If harvest will utilize the whole tree, 1 in 10 tops (less than or equal to 4" diameter) must be left scattered throughout the sale.
- Do not cut snags except for those that pose a safety hazard.
- Do not damage any survey monuments.
- Sale operations may only occur when the ground is frozen unless written permission is granted by Bayfield County.
- To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
