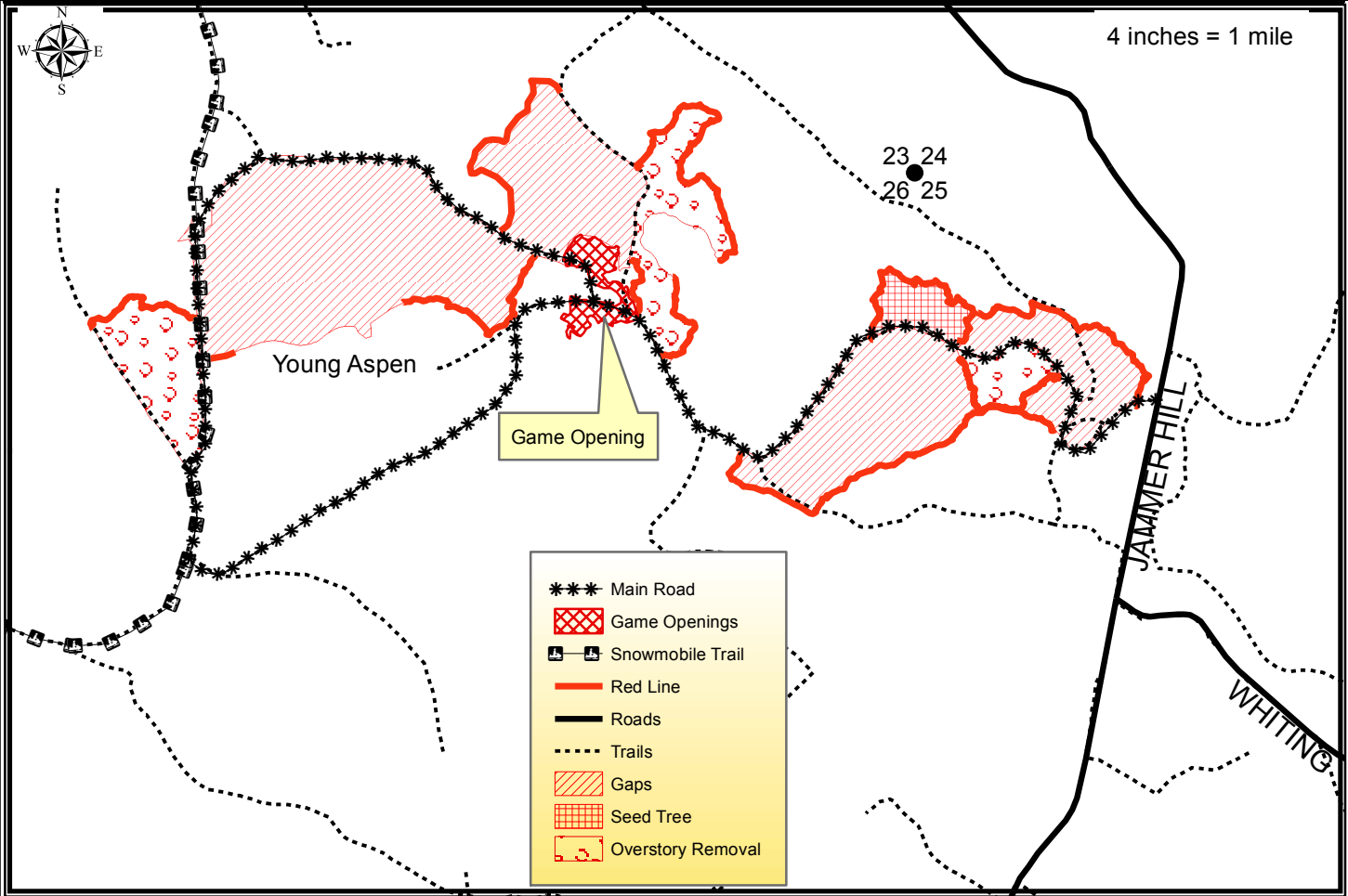

Harvest Requirements:

- This sale is being sold on a ticket sale basis.
- Sale boundaries are designated by red paint line, trails or abrupt timber type changes to young aspen or open areas.
- **Gaps:** Harvest all unmarked merchantable hardwood stems and all merchantable conifer stems, except hemlock and cedar, within the purple painted gaps. Do not harvest hemlock, cedar or trees marked with purple paint within the gap. Gaps are painted with two-dot purple facing the center of the gap. 12-16 border trees per gap are painted in purple. Gaps are ½ acre in size and approximately 400 feet apart. 0-3 leave trees per gap were marked with purple paint. The back of the trees with dots are painted with a purple slash to aid in locating the gap. Sever all non-merchantable stems, except hemlock and cedar, down to 1" in diameter in the gaps. Do not harvest any trees outside of the gaps. Scarification within the gap is highly encouraged. **No sale operations permitted between breakup and July 1st.**
- **Seed Tree:** Harvest all merchantable stems except hemlock, cedar and those marked with purple paint. Leave all hemlock, cedar and purple painted trees. Sever all non-merchantable stems 2" and greater, except hemlock and cedar.
- **Overstory Removal:** Harvest all merchantable stems, except hemlock, cedar and those marked with purple paint. Leave all hemlock, cedar and purple painted trees. Damage to existing regeneration must be minimized.
- **Harvest all stems within 20 feet of the edge of the main road (Approximately 3 Miles)**
- **Portions of the main road (Approximately 1.5 miles) will need improvement (See Attached Jammer Hill Road Project Map for Specifications).**
- During winter harvesting the snowmobile trail must be kept unobstructed and in a packed snow condition. The purchaser must insure that harvesting and hauling operations will not create a safety hazard to snowmobiles.
- Do not cut snags except for those that pose a safety hazard.
- To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
- If harvest will utilize the whole tree, 1 in 10 tops must be left scattered throughout the sale.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
