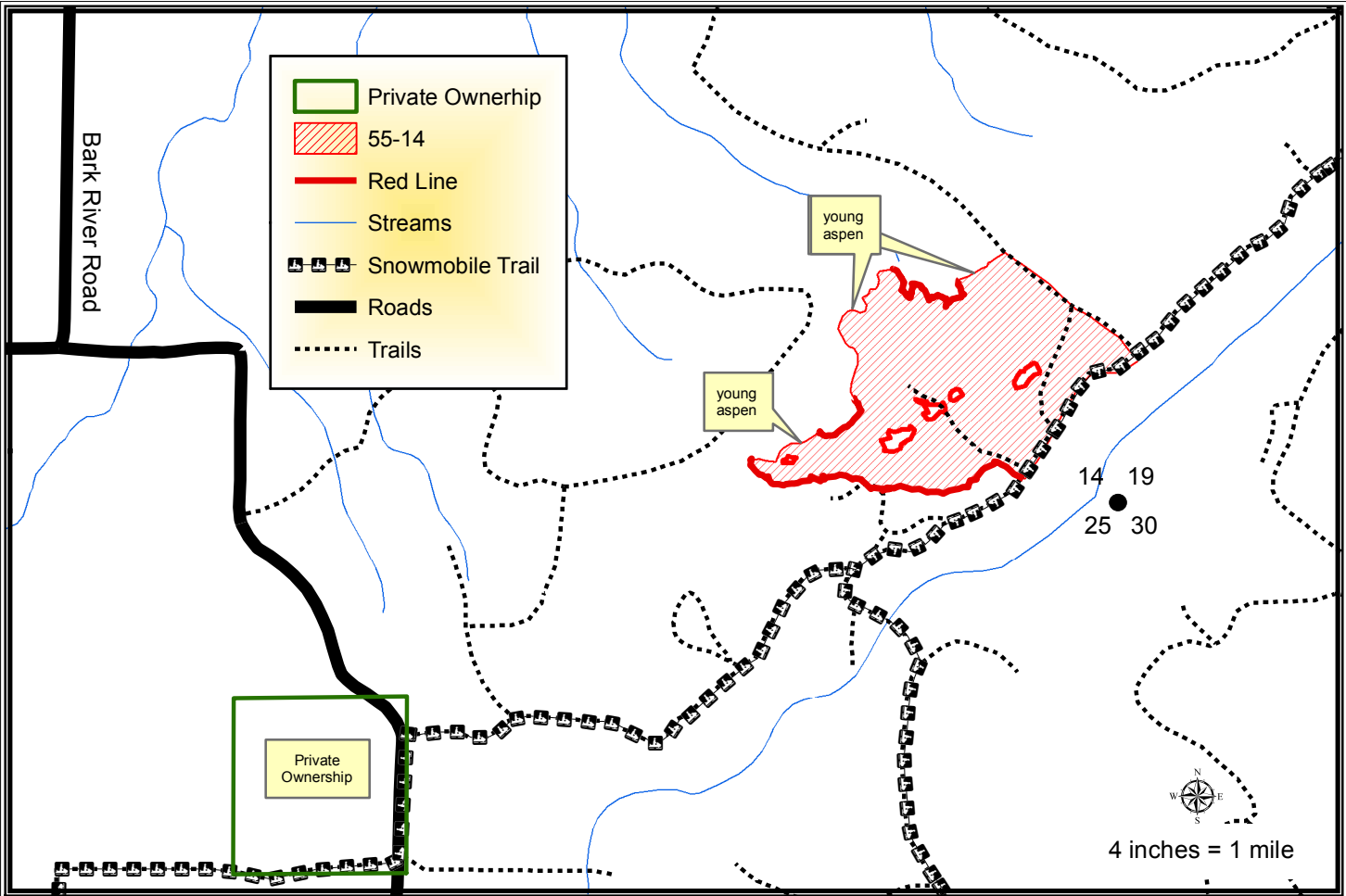

Harvest Requirements:

- Sale is an oak seed tree being sold on a Ticket Scale Basis.
- Harvest all merchantable timber. Do not harvest any purple marked trees.
- Stand boundaries are identified by red painted line, roads, trails or a significant change in timber type (young aspen).
- Several wet seeps have been identified and excluded from the sale. Others may exist within the sale boundaries not identified on the map. Avoid to the max extent possible.
- Sale operations may only occur when the ground is frozen or dry as determined by Bayfield County.
- During winter harvesting the snowmobile trail must be kept unobstructed and in a packed snow condition. The purchaser must insure that harvesting and hauling operations will not create a safety hazard to snowmobiles.
- Do not cut snags except for those that pose a safety hazard.
- An underground power line runs alongside the snowmobile trail and other forest roads between Swedlund Road and Stone Road. Several electrical breaker boxes can be found along the length of the snowmobile trail and other forest roads. Contractor shall take all precautions in order to avoid damage to buried and above ground utilities. The Contractor shall contact Diggers Hotline at least three (3) days prior to performing any road construction or work.
- If harvest will utilize the whole tree, 1 in 10 tops must be left scattered throughout the sale.
- The snowmobile trail crosses a small portion of private ownership off of Swedlund Road. Access on this preexisting trail through private property to the west of the sale has been secured and shall be left in the same or better condition as found.
- To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
