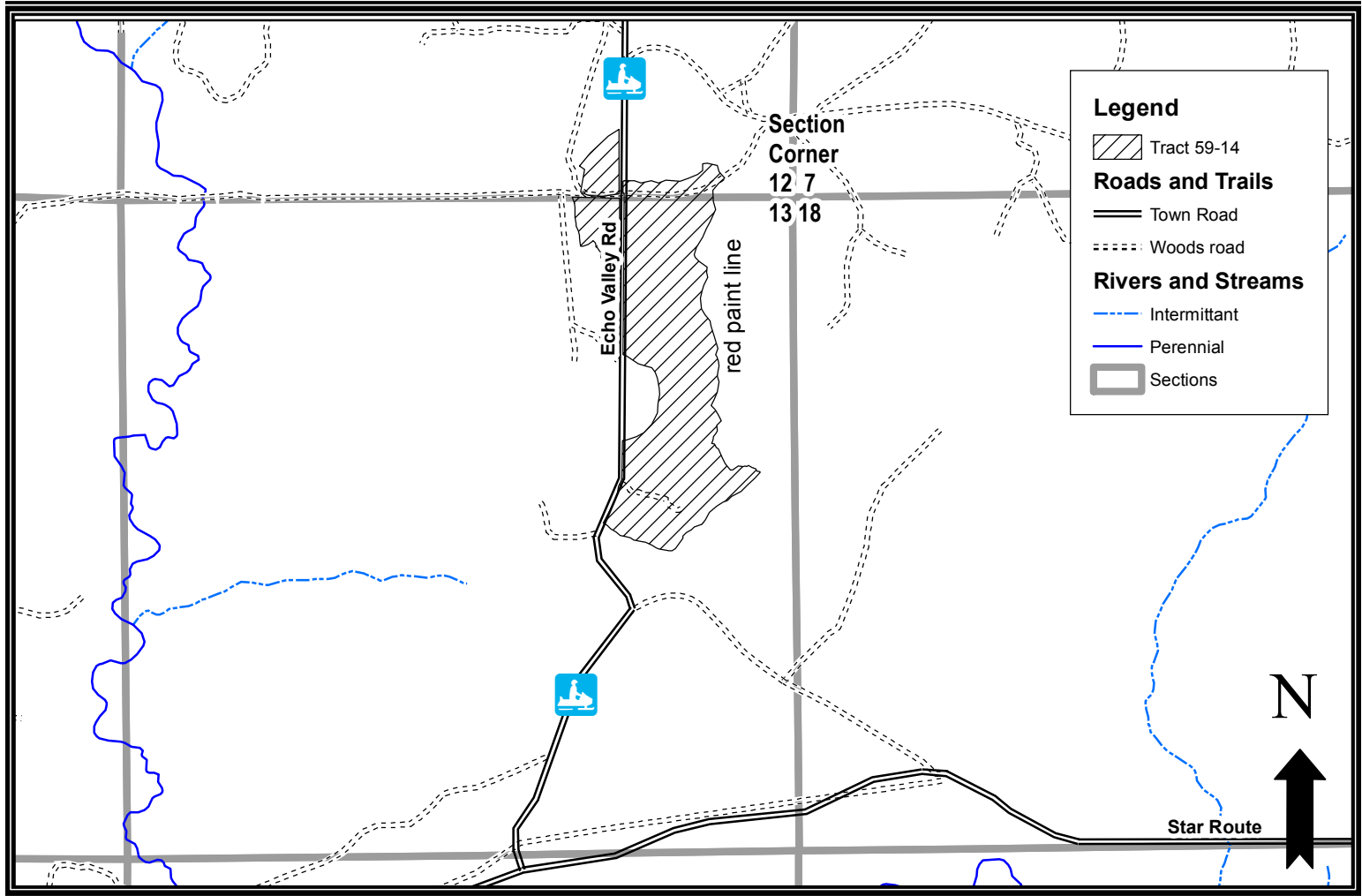

Harvest requirements:

- This is a ticket sale.
- Sale boundaries are red paint lines on the north, east, and south; cover type changes, and Echo Valley Road.
- This is an overstory removal to release established saplings. Care must be taken to not damage saplings.
- Sale may be whole-tree harvested but not whole-tree skidded, unless operator can demonstrate that skidding can be done without damaging advanced regeneration.
- DO NOT CUT hardwood marked with purple paint. CUT all other merchantable (6" DBH and larger) hardwood.
- LEAVE all conifer.
- Do not cut snags, except those that pose a hazard to logging operations.
- Do not damage any survey monumentation.
- Prior to moving equipment on to or off the sale area, scrape or brush debris and soil from exterior surfaces.
- All roads are in place. This contract requires county authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission of Bayfield County.
- Purchaser must ensure that harvesting and hauling operations will not create a safety hazard to snowmobiles. During winter harvest, snowmobile trail must be kept in a packed-snow condition.
