

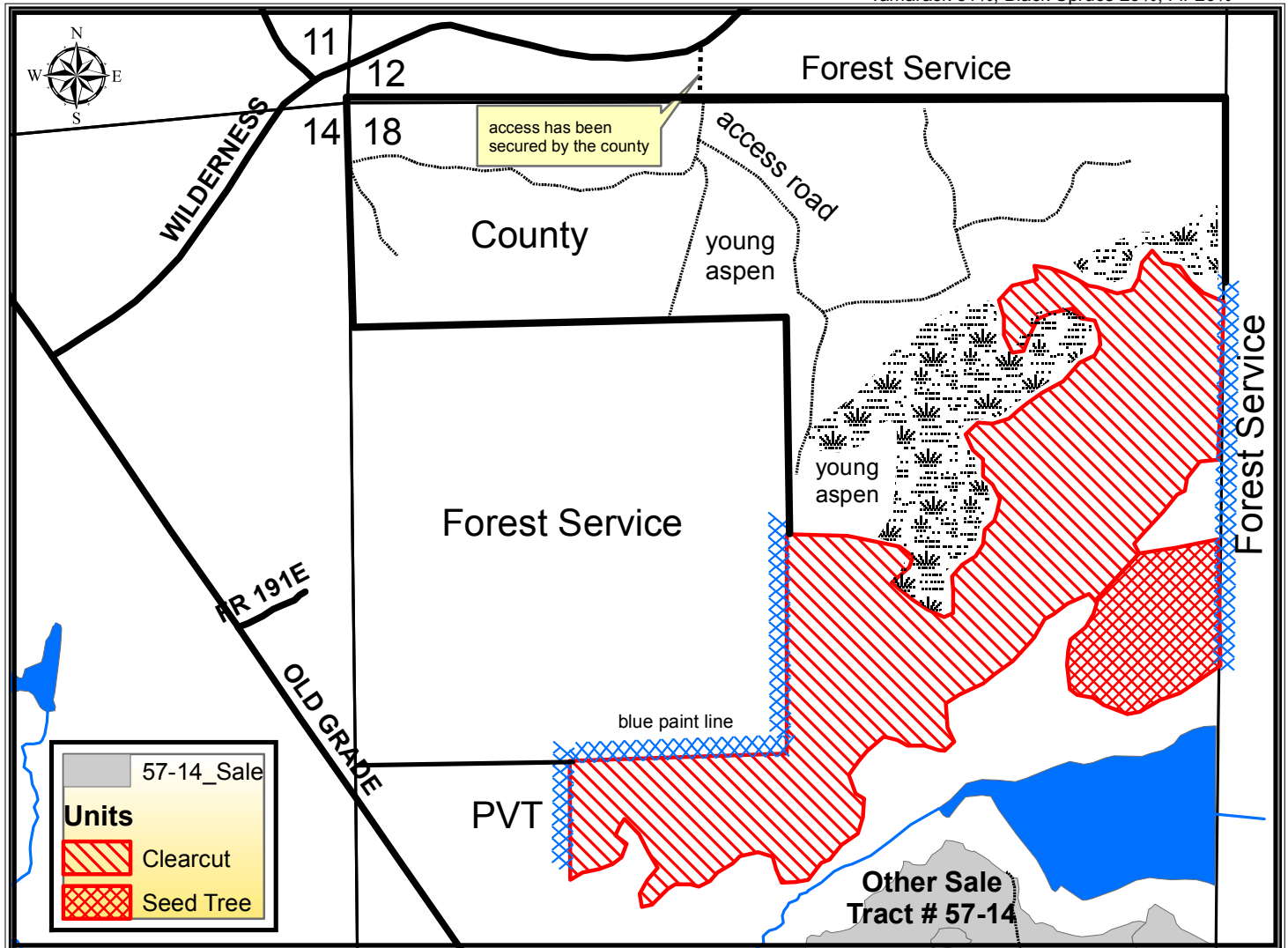

- Harvest Requirements:**
- This sale is being sold on a Ticket Scale Basis and whole tree harvesting is not allowed
 - Sale must be harvested in frozen ground conditions
 - The sale boundaries are marked in red paint and blue paint
 - **Prescription:**
 - **Clearcut Unit:** Harvest all merchantable trees. Sever all non-merchantable hardwood stems. Leave all red oak, white pine, red pine, cedar, hemlock
 - **Seed Tree Unit:** Harvest all merchantable trees. Leave all green painted trees, cedar, hemlock, white pine and red pine.
 - Clearcut unit is approximately 50% tamarack and black spruce swamp and 50% high ground aspen, red maple, birch, fir/spruce.
 - Seed tree unit is made up of maple, ash, basswood. Scattered green trees are marked to leave. Steep hills exist on the edges of this unit.
 - There is blue line marking the west and east sides of this sale. These blue lines denote a change of ownership. No trees and equipment may cross this blue paint line.
 - Access off Wilderness Road through US Forest Service has been secured, but contractor must notify the county **4 weeks prior** to moving into the sale to allow the proper permits to be issued.
 - Access roads will get you near the timber sale but new roads will need to be built into the sale. Sale administrator needs to approve all new road construction.
 - Do not cut snags except those that pose a safety hazard
 - Do not damage any survey monuments.
 - To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces of the logging equipment.
 - This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure. (refer to Sec. 17)
