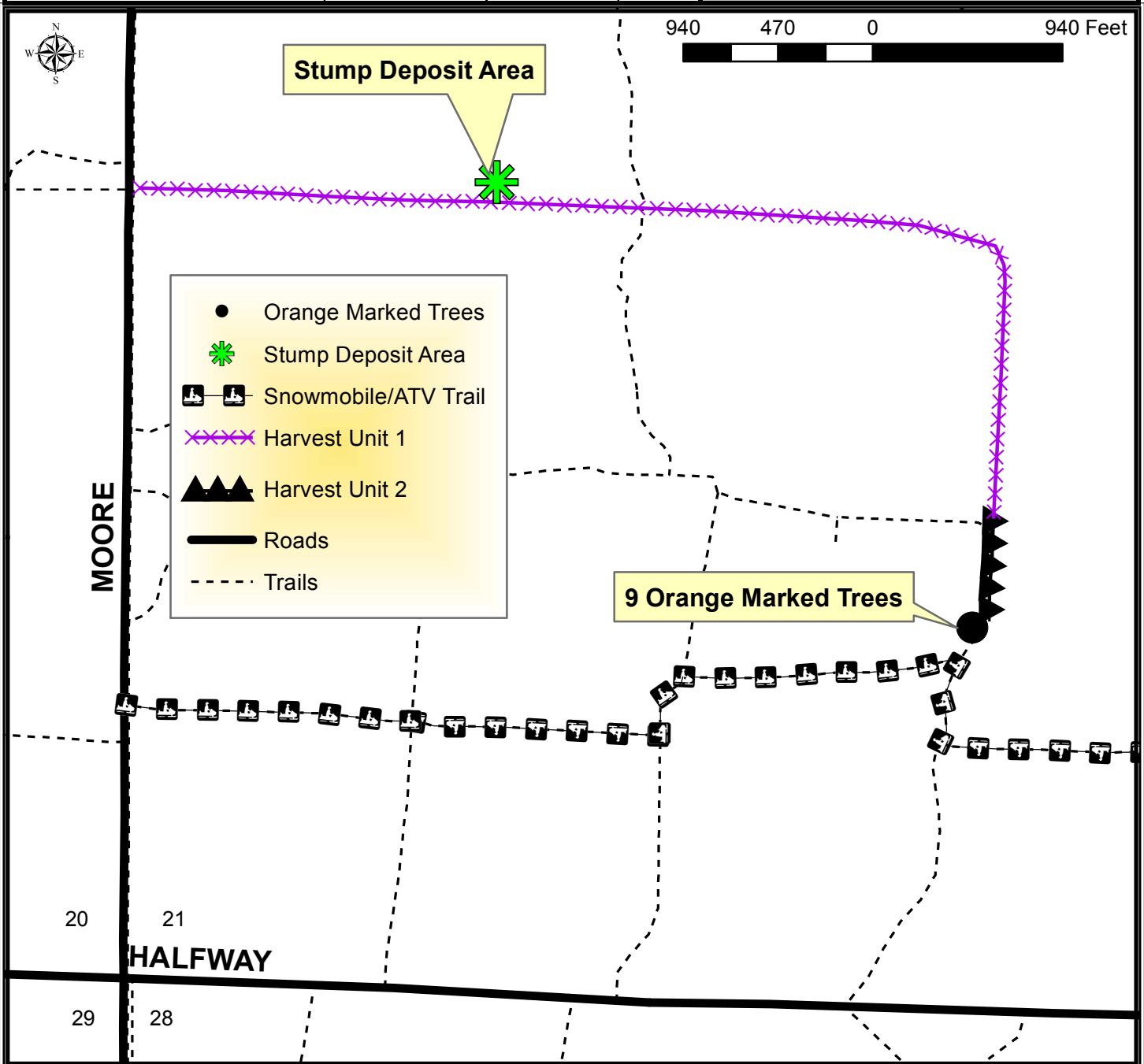

# TRACT 37-18 – HARVEST REQUIREMENTS

The following terms and conditions supplement those provided in the Bayfield County Timber Sale Contract.

## A. PRESCRIPTION:

1. Harvest unit 1 has a clearcut prescription with an estimated average residual basal area of 0 ft<sup>2</sup>.
2. Harvest unit 2 has a clearcut prescription with an estimated average residual basal area of 0 ft<sup>2</sup>.

## B. HARVEST REQUIREMENTS:

1. In harvest unit 1, Harvest all merchantable stems and sever all non-merchantable stems 2" and greater within 50 feet on each side of the purple painted line. Cut all snags.
2. In harvest unit 2, Harvest all merchantable stems and sever all non-merchantable stems 2" and greater within 50 feet of the center of the existing trail on the east side only. Cut all snags.
3. Harvest and remove stumps of a group of nine orange painted trees indicated on the map.

## C. OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS AND SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS:

1. Harvested pine cannot be kept on Bayfield County Forest for more than three weeks from May 1<sup>st</sup> to August 31<sup>st</sup>.

## D. ACCESS AND ROADS:

1. This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
2. Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.

## E. OTHER:

1. In harvest unit 1, remove all stumps (approximately 775 stumps) within 15 feet on each side of the purple painted line.
2. In harvest unit 2, remove all stumps (approximately 75 stumps) within 10 feet on the east side of the existing trail.
3. All stumps must be placed in a location, approved by Bayfield County, that is at least 66 feet away from the road. The general area is indicated on the sale map.
4. This sale is being sold as a short term contract which will end on June 30, 2019 with no extensions.
5. To comply with Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
