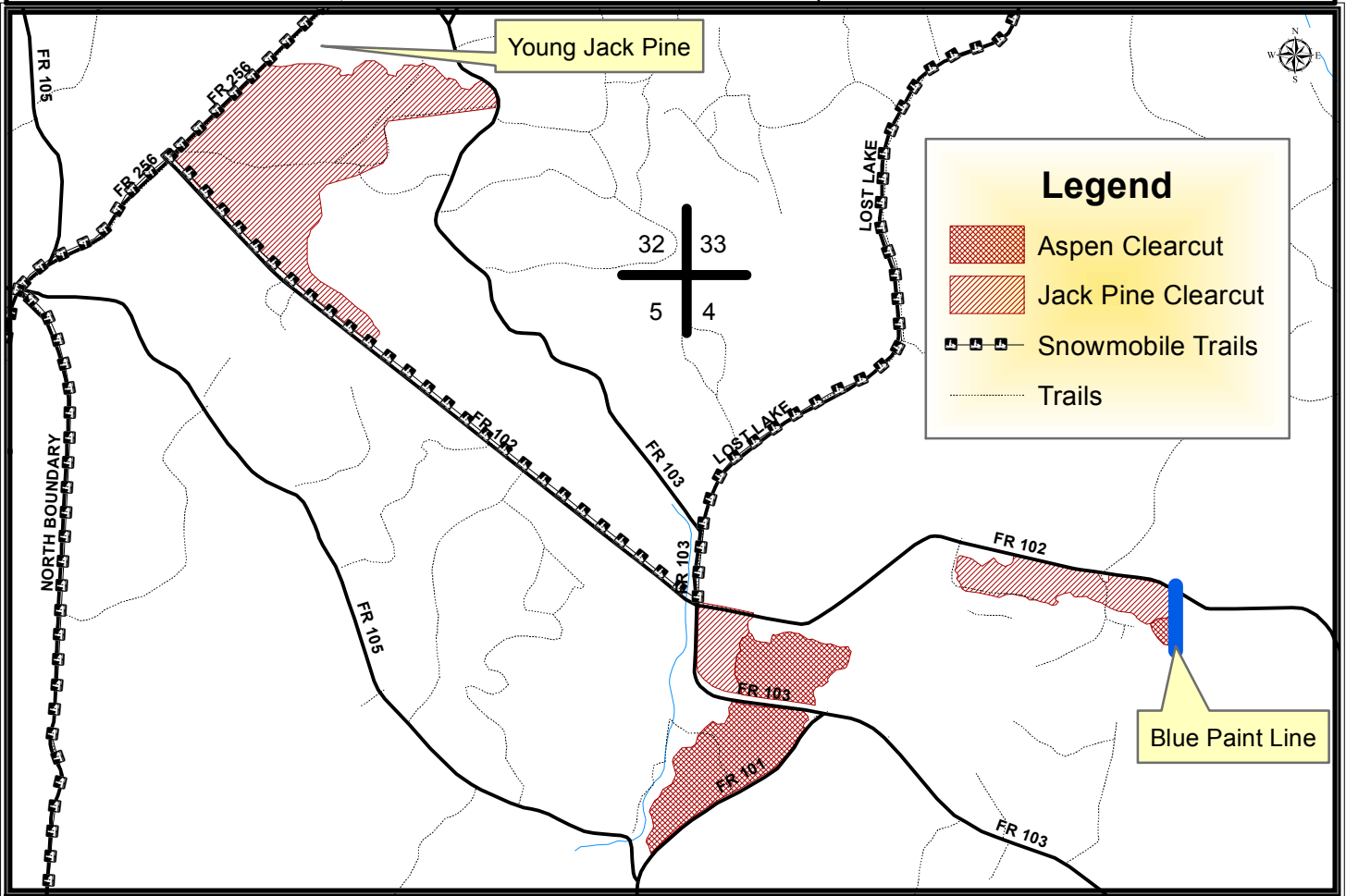

## Harvest Requirements:

- Sale is a clearcut being sold on a ticket scale basis.
- Sale boundaries consist of red paint line, blue paint line, town roads, or young jack pine.
- The blue line indicates private property. No equipment or felled trees may cross the line.
- Jack Pine Clearcut: Cut all stems 2" and greater.
- Aspen Clearcut: Leave all conifer except jack pine and leave all purple marked trees. Cut all stems 2" and greater. Do not cut snags except for those that pose a safety hazard.
- Harvested pine cannot be kept on the Bayfield County Forest for more than three weeks from May 1<sup>st</sup> to August 31<sup>st</sup>.
- Whole tree harvesting and/or utilization of tops less than 4" diameter will not be allowed.
- During winter harvesting the snowmobile trail must be kept unobstructed and in a packed snow condition. The purchaser must ensure that harvesting and hauling operations will not create a safety hazard to snowmobiles.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
- To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
