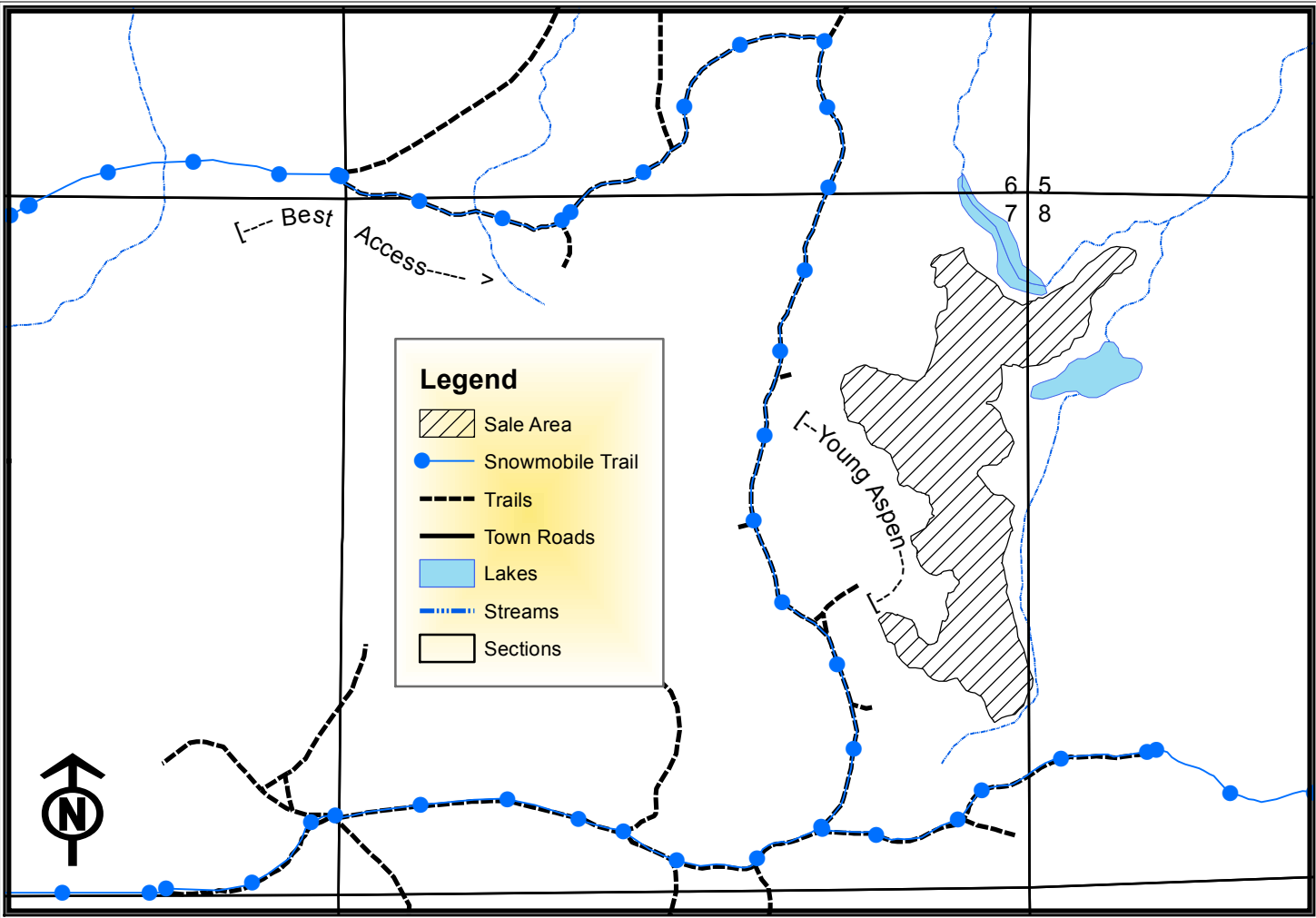

### Harvest Requirements:

- This 62-acre aspen/swamp hardwood clearcut is being sold on a Ticket Scale Basis.
- External sale boundaries are formed by red line and one obvious change in timber type.
- **Prescription:** Leave all purple-marked trees and all cedar, hemlock, and pine. Cut all unmarked hardwoods  $\geq 2''$  in diameter and all balsam and spruce  $\geq 5''$ .
- Approximately 2/3 of the sale (the eastern side) will require extended dry soil conditions, as determined by County, or frozen ground harvesting.
- Sale may be whole-tree harvested and whole-tree skidded without the usual requirement to leave 1-in-10 tops.
- Do not cut snags except for those that pose a safety hazard.
- During winter harvesting the snowmobile trail must be kept unobstructed and in a packed-snow condition. The purchaser must ensure that harvesting and hauling operations will not create a safety hazard to snowmobilers. Avoid damaging all signs and trail markers.
- To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
