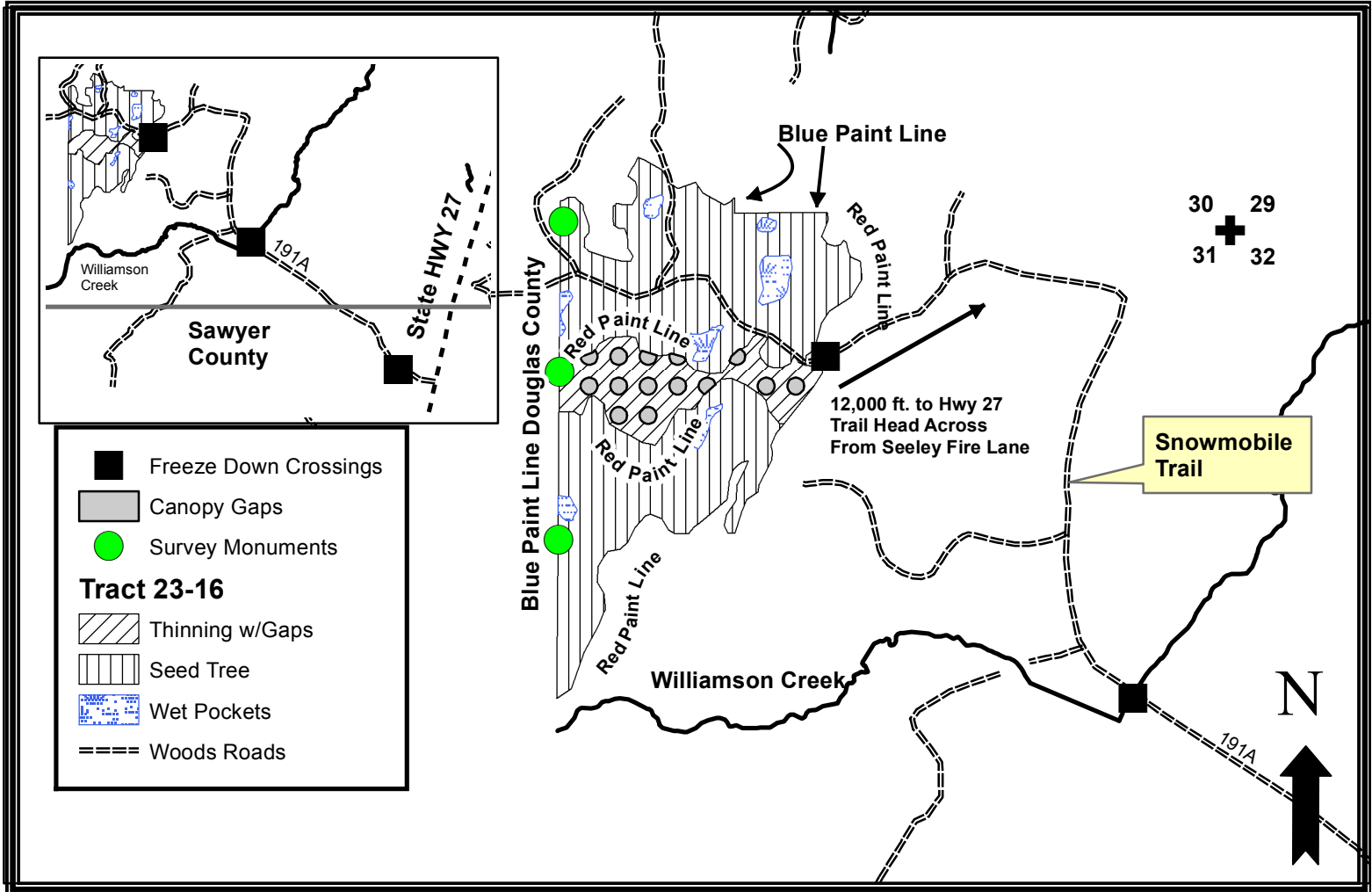

## Harvest requirements:

- Sale is being sold on a Ticket Sale basis.
- **Thinning w/Gaps:** There are purple painted canopy gaps (6-8 two dot purple painted trees on perimeter facing in towards the gap) **HARVEST ALL** merchantable trees as well as sever all trees 1" diameter and greater within the purple painted canopy gaps. There are no trees marked for removal between gaps. However, operational trees may be taken focusing on the smallest and lowest quality trees.
- **Seed Tree:** Harvest all hardwoods 2" diameter and larger including ironwood.
- **LEAVE** all green and purple painted trees and all conifers.
- Do not damage any survey monumentation.
- Prior to moving equipment on to or off the sale area, scrape or brush debris and soil from exterior surfaces.
- Do not cut snags except those that pose a safety hazard to logging operations.
- All roads are in place. This contract requires county authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
- Decking of wood along recreational trails and roads will not be allowed without permission of Bayfield County.
- During winter harvesting, the snowmobile trail must be kept unobstructed and in a packed snow condition. The purchaser must ensure that harvesting and hauling operations will not create a safety hazard to snowmobiles.
- The access road (winter recreational trail 217) is west off Highway 27 and originates in Sawyer County, across and north 600 feet from the Seeley Fire Lane.
- Sale operations may only occur when the ground is frozen.
- This map is not a survey of the actual boundary of any property this map depicts.
- The two eastern freeze down crossings are existing permitted fords.
