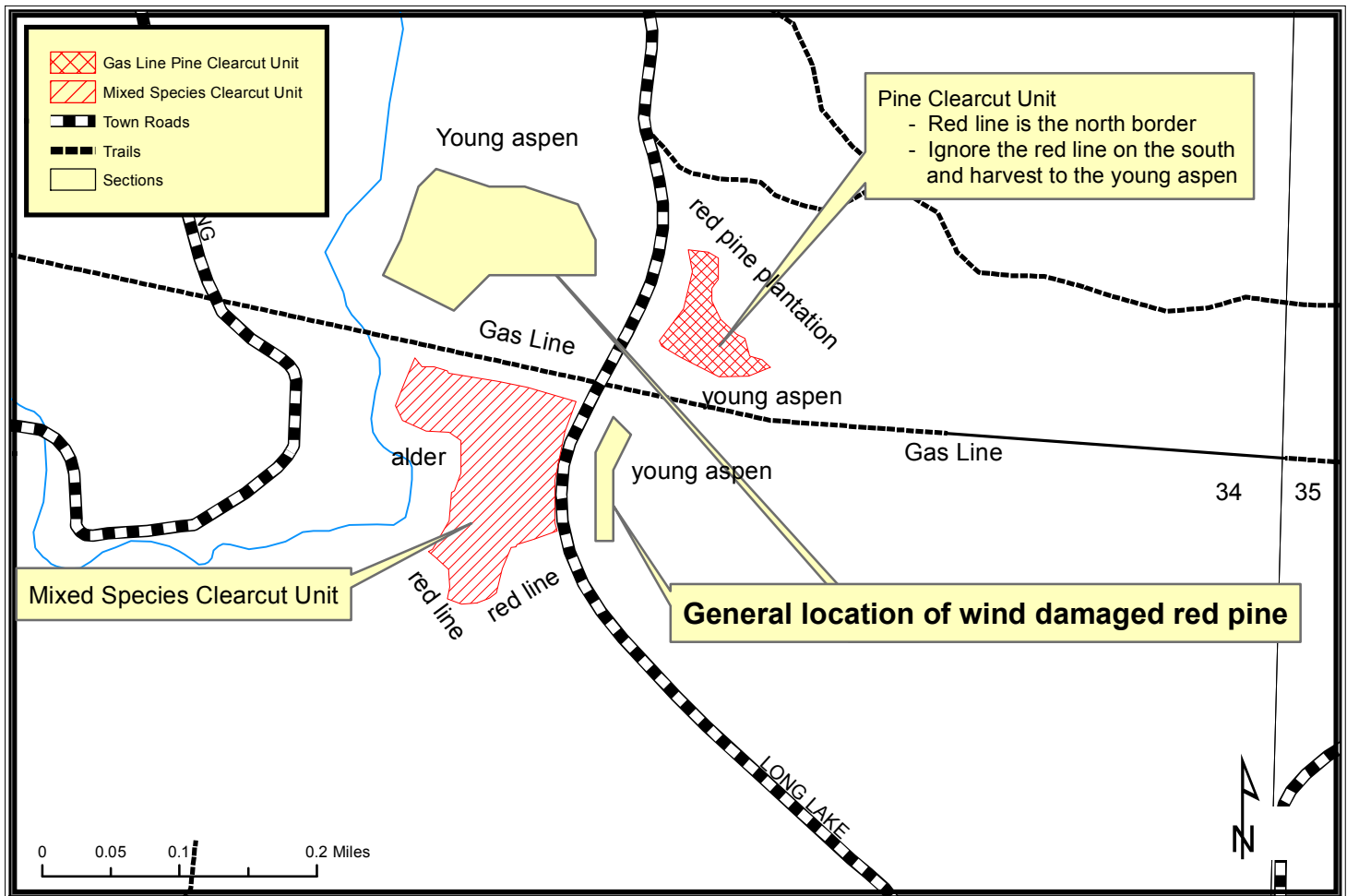

Harvest Requirements:

- Sale is a **salvage harvest** and will be sold on a Ticket Scale Basis
- Sale boundaries for the Pine Clearcut Unit: Red line is the north boundary, young aspen on the south and west, see map for details on ignoring the southern red line within this unit.
- Sale boundaries for the Mixed Species Clearcut Unit: Alder brush is the west boundary, red line is the south boundary, Long Lake road is the east boundary, and the gas line is the north boundary.
- There is an area north and west of the gas line and Long Lake road where there are approx. 70 wind damaged red pine trees (tipped, root sprung, leaned on, blow down, broken off) mixed in with undamaged trees. Only harvest the wind damaged pine.
- The area south and east of Long Lake road includes approx. 10 wind damaged pine. They are visible in the 1 year old aspen stand from the road. Harvested pine cannot be kept on the Bayfield County Forest for more than three weeks from May 1st to August 31st.
- To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- If harvest will utilize the whole tree, 1 in 10 tops must be left scattered throughout the sale.
- If the Natural Gas pipeline needs to be crossed, Digger's hotline must mark the line and the pipeline company must be contacted prior to crossing. The pipeline company may place conditions on crossing the line. In the past they have requested that a soil lift be used where the road crosses the line.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
- Do not damage any survey monuments.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
- **CONTRACT WILL EXPIRE ON SEPT. 30, 2016. NO EXTENSION WILL BE GRANTED**
