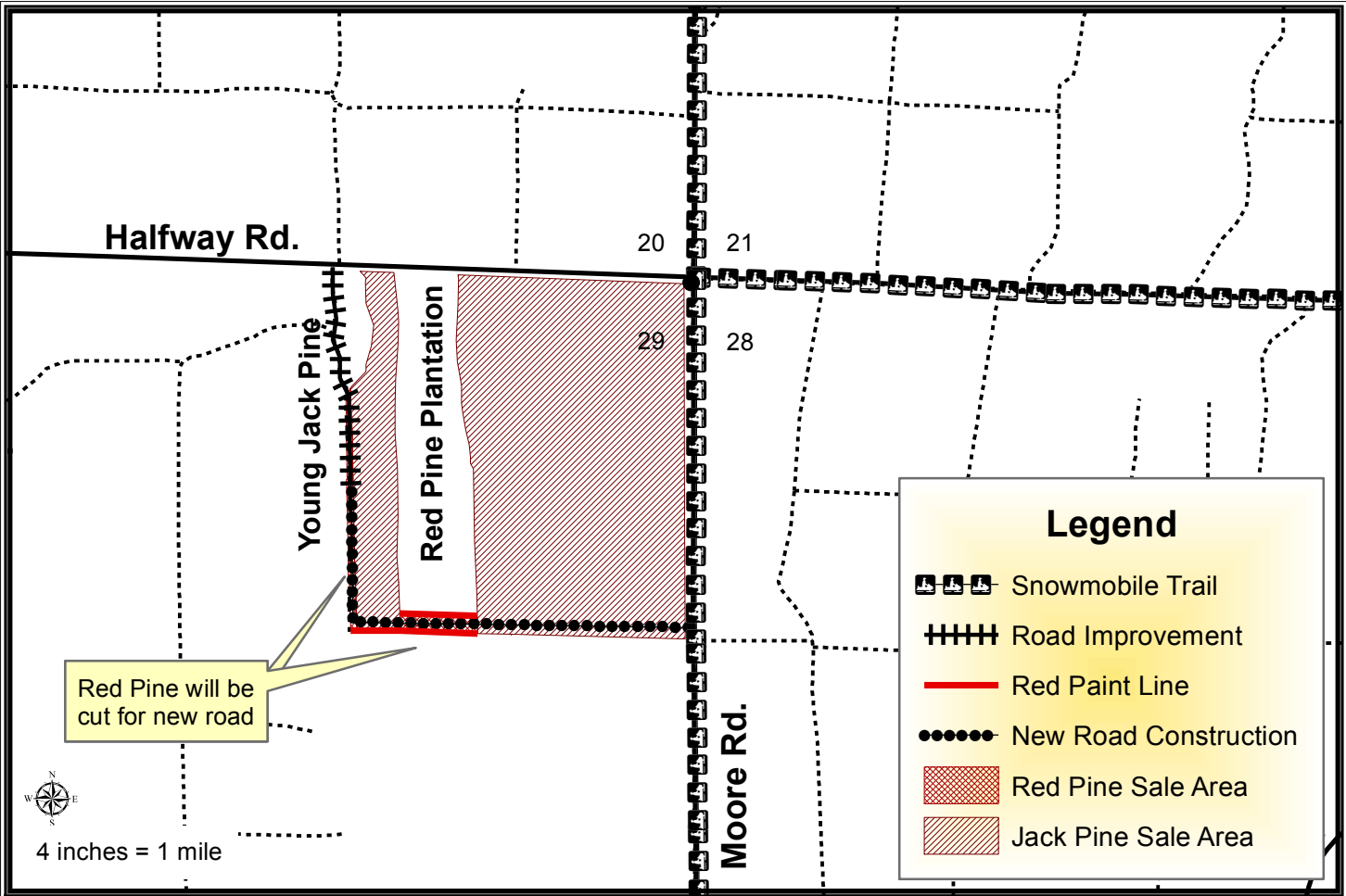

Harvest Requirements:

- Sale is a jack pine clearcut being sold on a ticket scale basis.
- Sale boundaries consist of red paint line, abrupt change in timber type to red pine or young jack pine, roads, and a snowmobile trail.
- Harvest all merchantable timber and sever all non-merchantable stems 2" in diameter and greater.
- Harvested pine cannot be kept on the Bayfield County Forest for more than three weeks from May 1st to August 31st.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
- To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
- During winter harvesting the snowmobile trail must be kept unobstructed and in a packed snow condition. The purchaser must insure that harvesting and hauling operations will not create a safety hazard to snowmobiles.
- This sale will require some new road construction and some road improvements.
 - New Road (3400 ft): Minimum 24 ft corridor cleared and stumped (clearing debris must be scattered and not piled). Road requires a 16 ft running deck that will be crowned and ditched with organics incorporated as much as possible.
 - Road Improvement (1600 ft): Road must have a 16 ft running deck that will be crowned and ditched with organics incorporated as much as possible. Harvest all merchantable timber within 50 ft of the center of the road.
