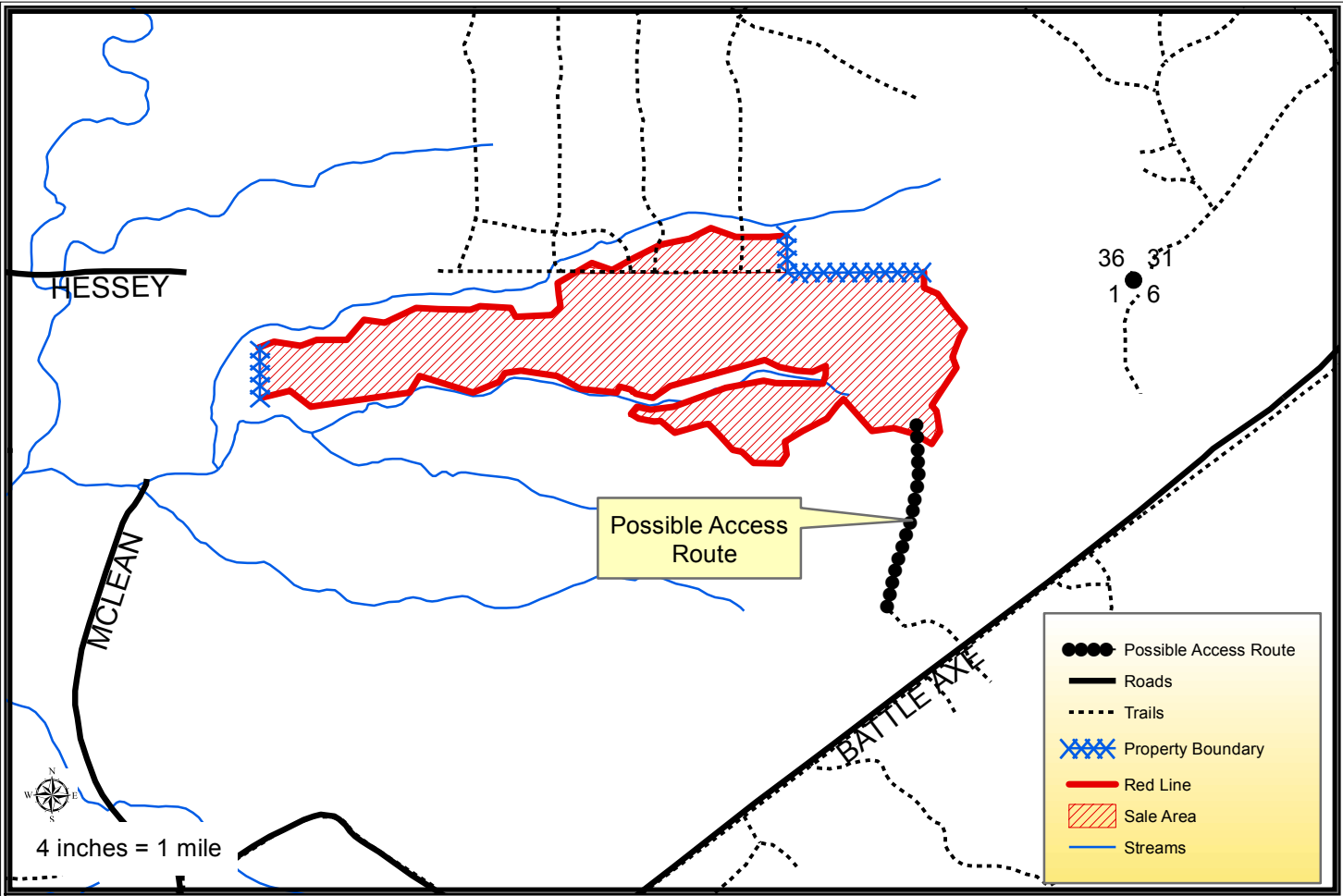

## Harvest Requirements:

- Sale is an aspen coppice being sold on a Ticket Scale Basis
- Sale boundaries consist of red paint line and blue paint line.
- The blue paint line indicates private property. No equipment or felled trees may cross the line.
- Harvest all merchantable hardwood stems, spruce, fir and jack pine. Sever all non-merchantable hardwood stems 2" in diameter and greater.
- Leave all conifer except jack pine, spruce and fir.
- Sale operation may only occur when the ground is frozen unless written permission is granted by Bayfield County.
- Approximately 1400 feet of new road will need to be constructed to access this sale from Battle Ax Road. A possible route is shown on the map, but may be altered to improve access with permission from Bayfield County.
- Do not cut snags except for those that pose a safety hazard.
- To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
