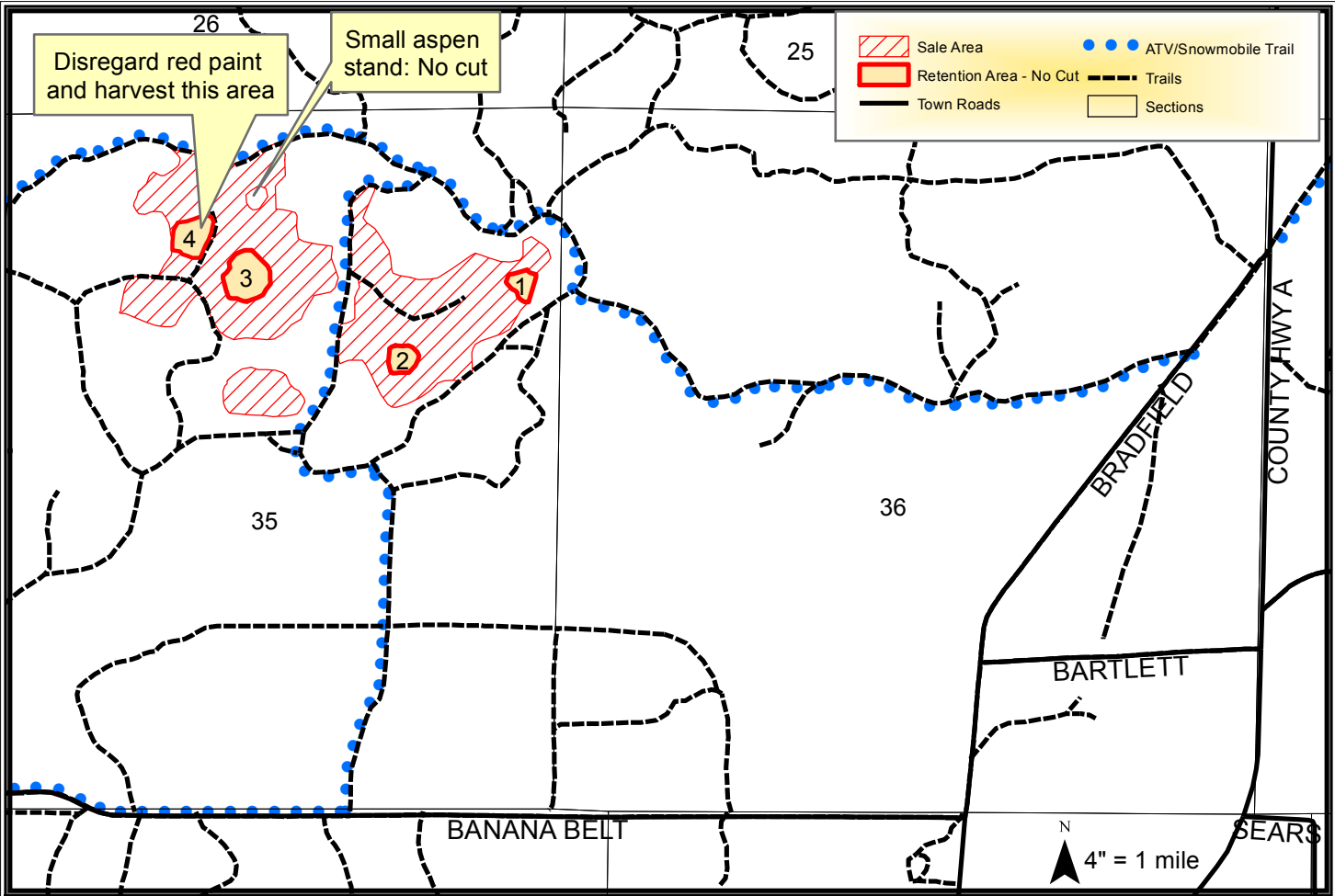

➤ This sale is 60-acre overstory removal of high-quality red oak and is being sold on a Ticket Scale Basis. 0 330 660 1,320 Feet

➤ Existing trails provide adequate access to the sale.

Harvest Requirements:

- The primary haul route utilizes a portion of the ATV/snowmobile trail. Excessive damage (beyond normal wear and tear) to the ATV/snowmobile trail, as determined by Bayfield County, will not be tolerated. If Bayfield County determines excessive damage has occurred, the Contractor may be held responsible for a portion or all of the repair. The County and Contractor must communicate on a regular basis to ensure issues are addressed in a timely manner and the trail remains in a safe and acceptable condition. The trails must be appropriately signed for safety. During winter harvesting the snowmobile trail must be kept unobstructed and in a snow-packed condition.
- Sale boundaries are formed by abrupt changes in timber types (5 year-old aspen and mature, fully-stocked aspen stands) and by trails in the northwest and southeast.
- Purchaser must minimize damage to regeneration during harvest operations.
- Whole-tree harvesting will be allowed but *not* whole-tree skidding in order to prevent damage to regeneration.
- Do not harvest within the three retention areas that outlined in red paint. Disregard a 4th retention area that was created in the far west.
- PRESCRIPTION: *LEAVE* all trees within the 3 retention units (disregard 4th western unit) that are outlined with red paint. *LEAVE* all scattered trees that are marked with red paint. *HARVEST* all other merchantable hardwoods.
- Do not cut snags except for those that pose a safety hazard.
- To comply with the BMPs for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
