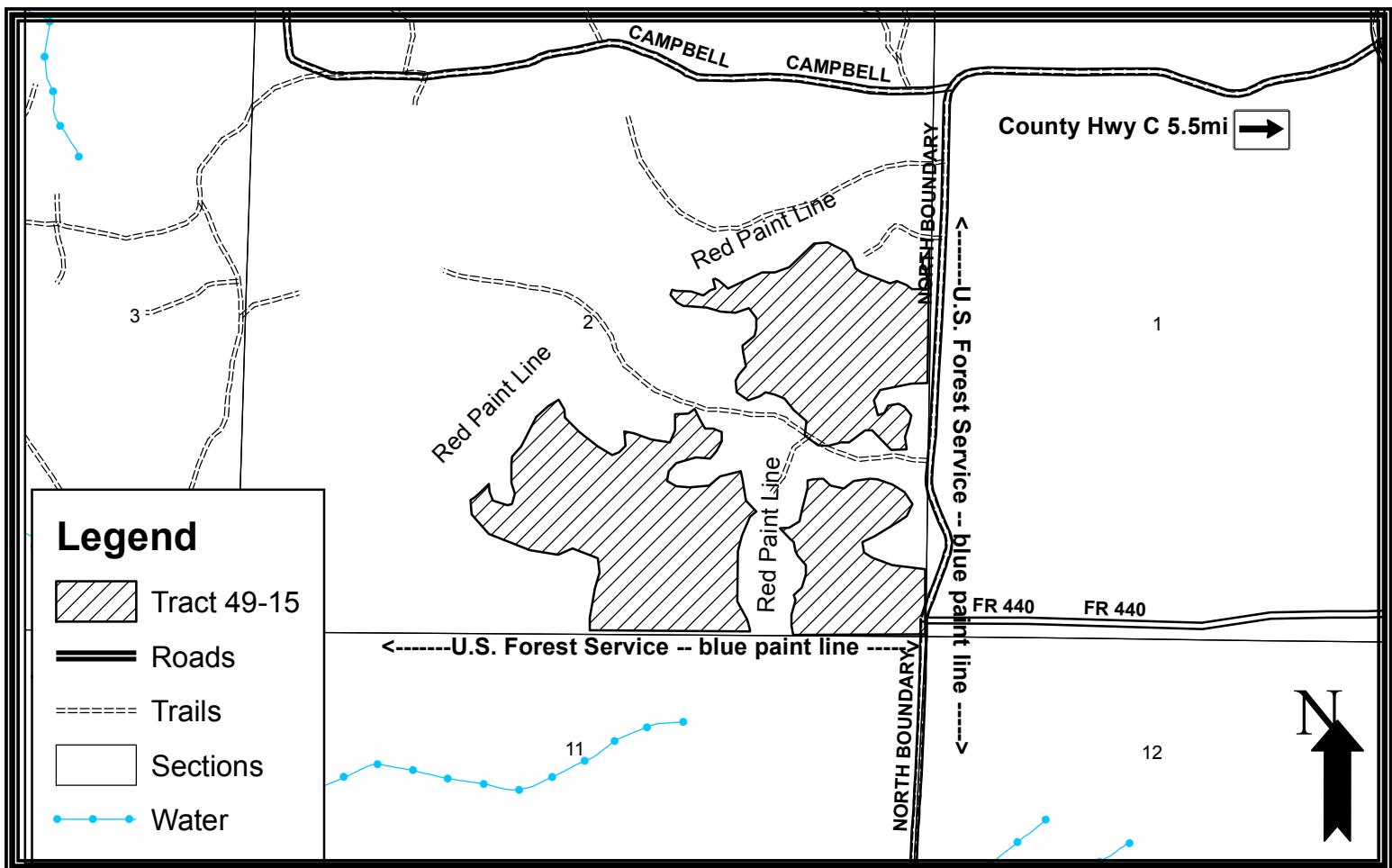

Harvest requirements:

- This is a ticket sale. Boundaries are marked in red and blue paint
- This is a seed tree harvest in red oak, aspen, and pine.
- Harvest all merchantable trees EXCEPT those marked with purple paint. Sever all stems 2" diameter at breast height and larger.
- Do not cut Red Pine.
- Do not damage any survey monumentation. No machinery or cut trees may cross the blue paint line onto Forest Service land.
- Prior to moving equipment on to or off the sale area, scrape or brush debris and soil from exterior surfaces.
- All roads are in place. This contract requires county authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission of Bayfield County.
- Harvested pine cannot be kept on the Bayfield County Forest for more than three weeks from May 1st to August 31st.
- All snags that do not pose a safety hazard will be left.
- If harvest will utilize the whole tree, 1 in 10 tops must be left scattered throughout the sale.
- This map is not a survey of the actual boundary of any property this map depicts.
- The east boundary was recently re-established with blazes and fresh blue paint (approx. 20' east of the old blue trees). The newly blazed and blue painted trees is the boundary line. Ignore all old blue painted trees.
