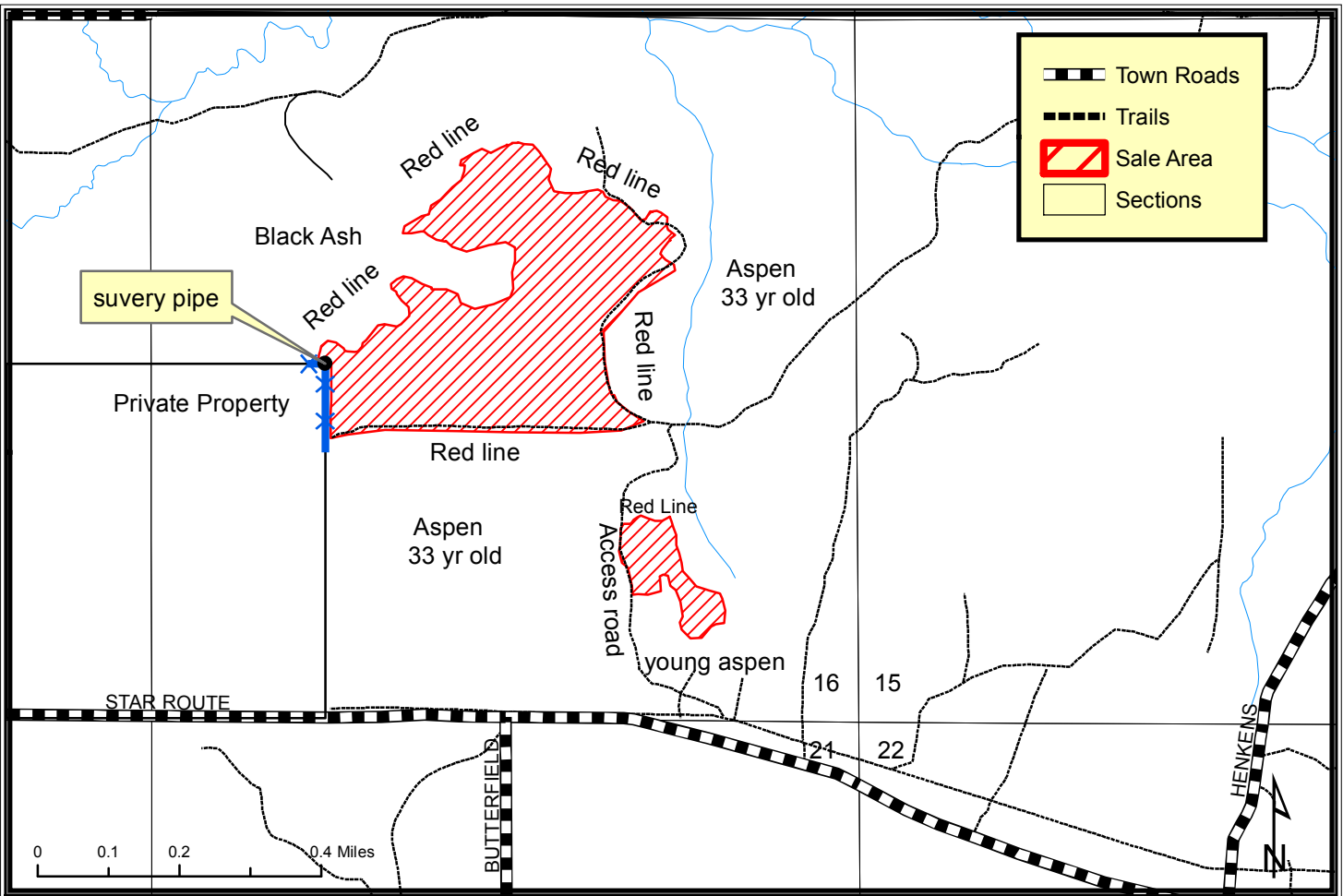

- Harvest Requirements:**
- Sale is a clearcut and will be sold on a Ticket Scale Basis
 - Sale boundaries for the north unit include a blue paint line on the west side. The rest of the boundaries are marked out in red paint. The southern unit has red line on the north and has trail on the west and recent clearcut to the south and east.
 - Prescription: Clearcut: Harvest all merchantable hardwoods except purple painted trees. Purple painted trees are only located in the southern unit. Harvest all merchantable spruce and fir. Leave all hemlock, pine, and cedar. Sever all hardwood stems 2 inches and larger. Do not cut snags except for those that pose a safety hazard.
 - The north unit is located on primarily clay and muck soils. Most of this sale must be harvested during frozen ground conditions. The south east portion may have potential to be harvested during a dry fall though such harvesting must be authorized by the sale administrator
 - The southern unit is located on sandy soil and has no seasonal restrictions.
 - The blue line indicates private property. No equipment or felled trees may cross the blue paint line.
 - This map is not a survey of the actual boundary of any property this map depicts.
 - To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
 - If harvest will utilize the whole tree, 1 in 10 tops must be left scattered throughout the sale.
 - Do not damage any survey monuments.
 - This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
