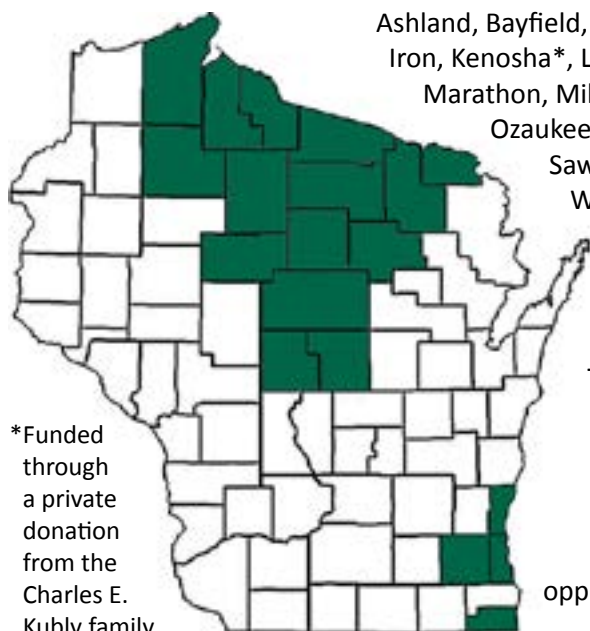

The goal of the Child Psychiatry Consultation Program (CPCP) is to improve mental health care for children in state of Wisconsin. We empower primary care providers to treat mental health care needs sooner, in patients' medical homes, and support them through education and consultation.

CPCP COMPONENTS

- Mental health education for primary care providers:
 - Pharmacology series: ADHD, Depression and Anxiety, Atypical Antipsychotics
 - Trauma Informed Care
 - Use of General and Specific Rating Scales (forthcoming)
- Availability of daily case consultation via emails and phone calls with a child psychiatrist or psychologist: Mondays-Fridays 8 a.m.–5 p.m., excluding holidays
- Organizing and disseminating information about regional mental health resources with resulting linkage of children and their families to these resources

This project is funded through Wisconsin Act 127. The Charles E. 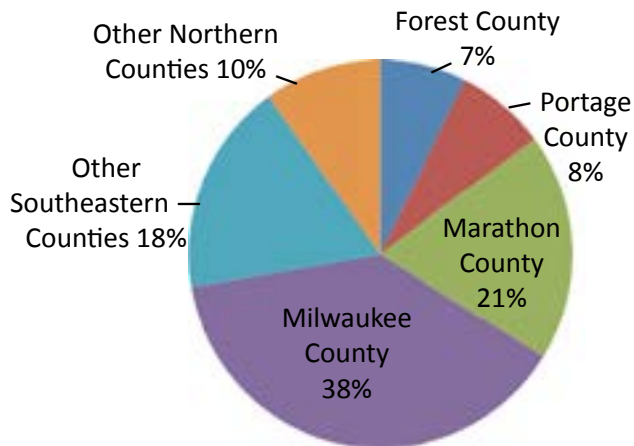
BY THE NUMBERS...

As of January, 2016 there are:

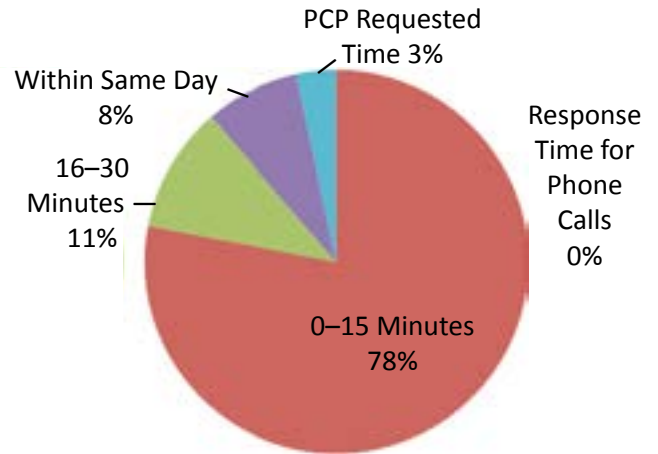
- 146 providers representing 39 clinics enrolled in the Milwaukee area
- 134 providers representing 40 clinics enrolled in the Northern Region

From January 2015 to January 2016 our team has provided 363 consultations through a combination of phone calls, emails, and letters/faxes.

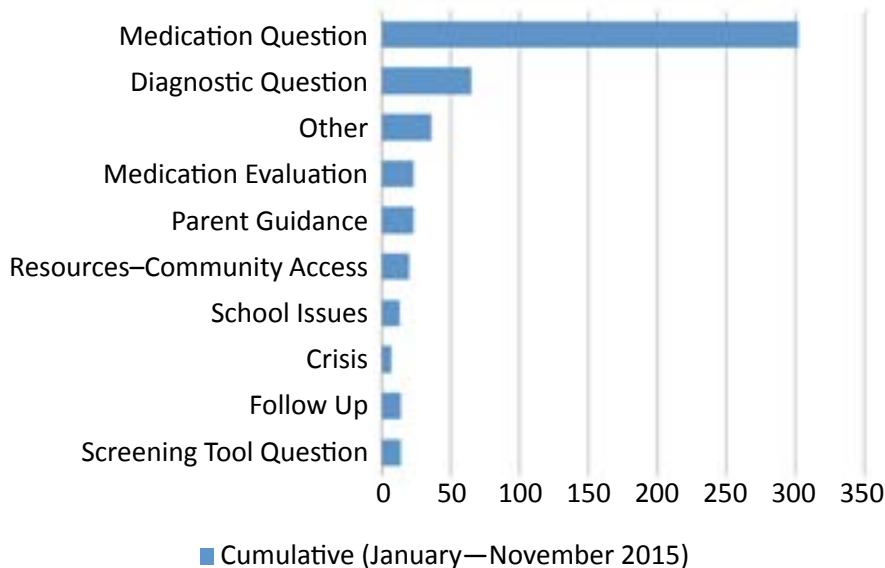
ENCOUNTER COUNTY OF ORIGIN
