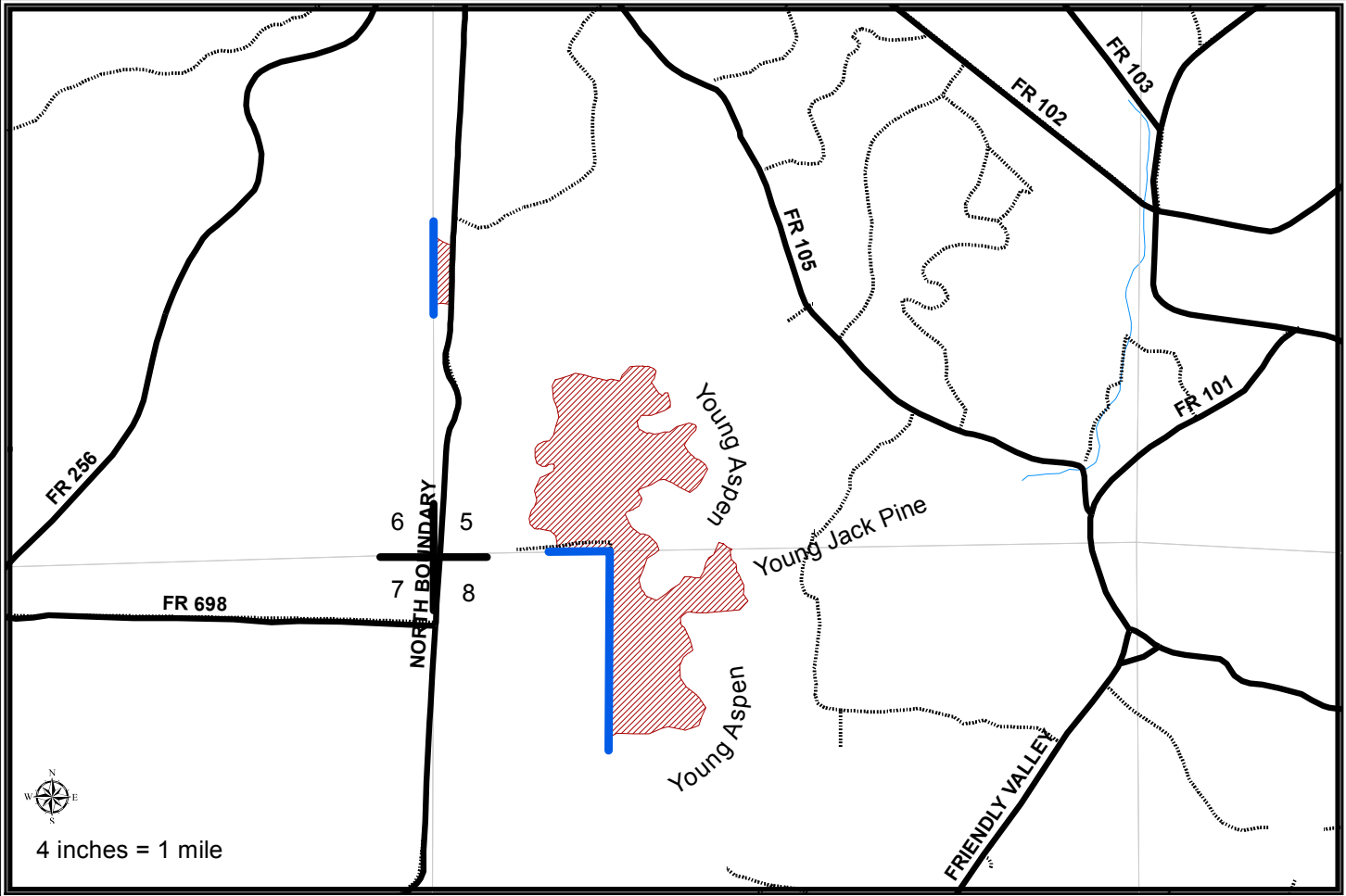

- Harvest Requirements:**
- Sale is a clearcut being sold on a Ticket Scale Basis
  - Sale boundaries consist of red paint line, blue paint line, roads, or a noticeable change in timber type.
  - The blue line indicates private property. No equipment or felled trees may cross the line.
  - Leave all purple marked trees and leave all conifer except jack pine.
  - Harvest all merchantable hardwood stems and sever all hardwood stems 2" diameter and greater.
  - This sale includes 3 trees that are painted with a purple "X". Operator must fell and leave all trees marked with a purple "X". "X" marked trees should be cut 5 ft above ground level and should lie as close to the high stump as possible. These trees will create ruffed grouse drumming habitat.
  - Do not cut snags except for those that pose a safety hazard.
  - To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
  - Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
  - Whole tree harvesting and/or utilization of tops less than 4" diameter will not be allowed.
  - This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
