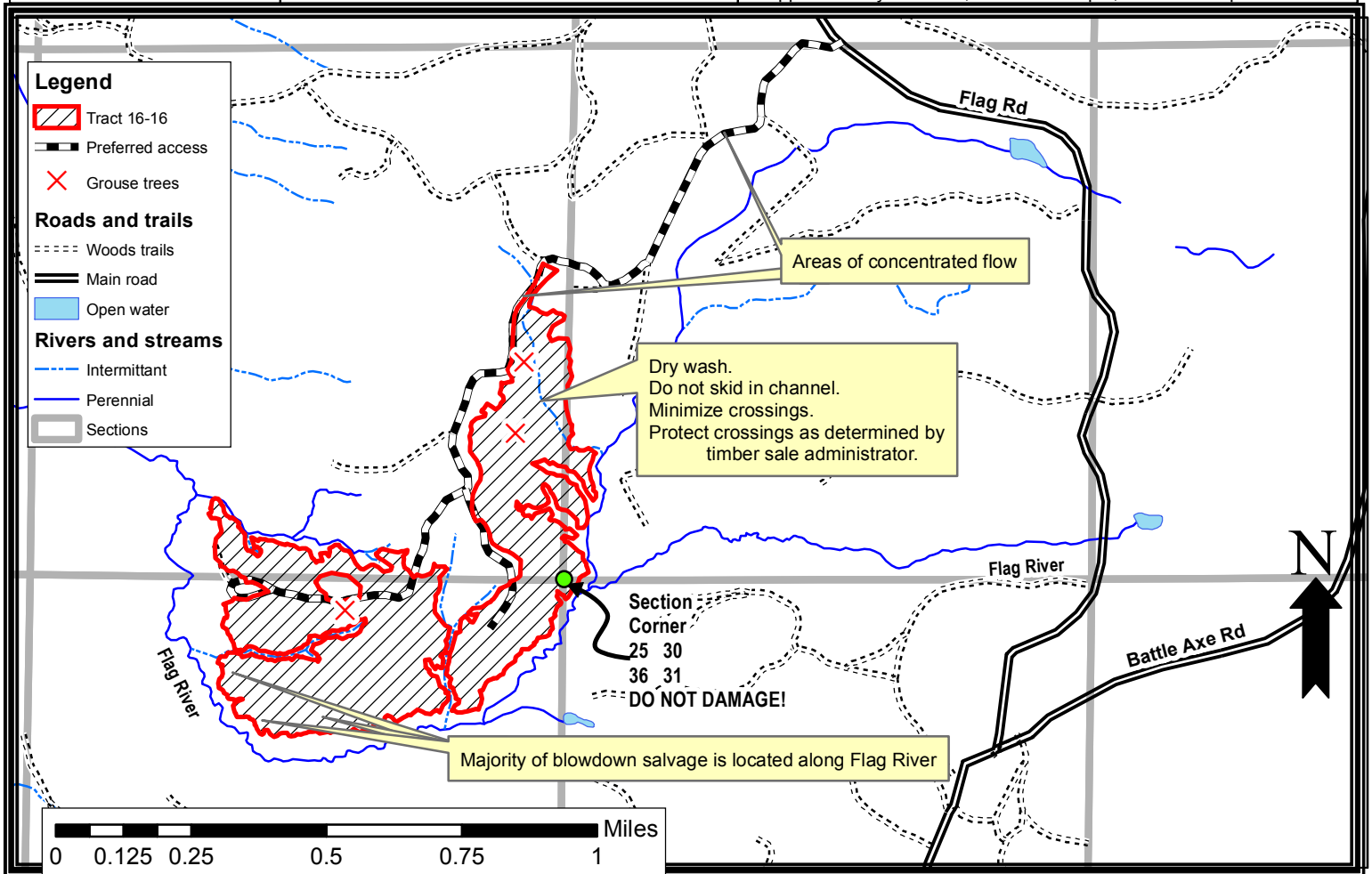

## Harvest requirements:

- This is a ticket sale to be harvested in dry or frozen season only, as determined by Bayfield County.
- Culverts or mats are in place on areas of concentrated flow in two places on the Preferred Access route. Follow BMPs for water quality for all drainage crossings and road slopes.
- Do not skid wood in dry wash indicated on map. If the dry wash must be crossed, then the crossing and approaches must be protected with pole ford or similar to avoid rutting and erosion.
- If the sale will be whole-tree harvested, leave one in ten tops scattered in the sale area.
- Sale boundaries are red paint lines.
- Do not cut snags except those that pose a safety hazard to logging operations.
- LEAVE all oak, elm, hemlock, cedar, pine, and spruce (less than 0.1 cord/acre of these species.)
- CUT all other trees two inches diameter and larger.
- This sale includes three trees that are painted with a red ring and a red "X". Operator must fell and leave all trees marked with a red "X". "X" marked trees should be cut above the red ring and should lie as close to the high stump as possible. These trees will create ruffed grouse drumming habitat.
- Do not damage any survey monumentation (note SECTION CORNER.)
- Flag Rd is a snowmobile and ATV trail. The purchaser must ensure that harvest and hauling operations will not create a safety hazard to snowmobiles or ATVs. If harvesting occurs during winter, trail must be kept unobstructed and in a packed-snow condition.
- Prior to moving equipment on to or off the sale area, scrape or brush debris and soil from exterior surfaces.
- This contract requires county authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission of Bayfield County.
