

CALCULATING YOUR FY2019 COUNTY TAXES



To calculate your county tax, multiply your Assessed Value by the County Mill Rate. The Assessed Value is generally between 80 and 90% of the actual value of a property. The estimated 2018 Mill Rate for Bayfield County is 3.71 mills. This means that for each \$1000 in assessed value, you will pay \$3.71. Note the mill levy above is an average and includes the county library levy, for those residents living within a library district already, the levy is slightly less.

Example: If your home/property has an Assessed Value of \$100,000:

$\$100,000 \times .00371 \text{ mills} = \371 for a year of County Taxes.

By dividing this amount over 12 periods, the monthly tax payment for county services can be calculated. In the above example of a property with an assessed value of \$100,000 a property owner would pay \$30.91 per month or a little more than \$1 per day.
