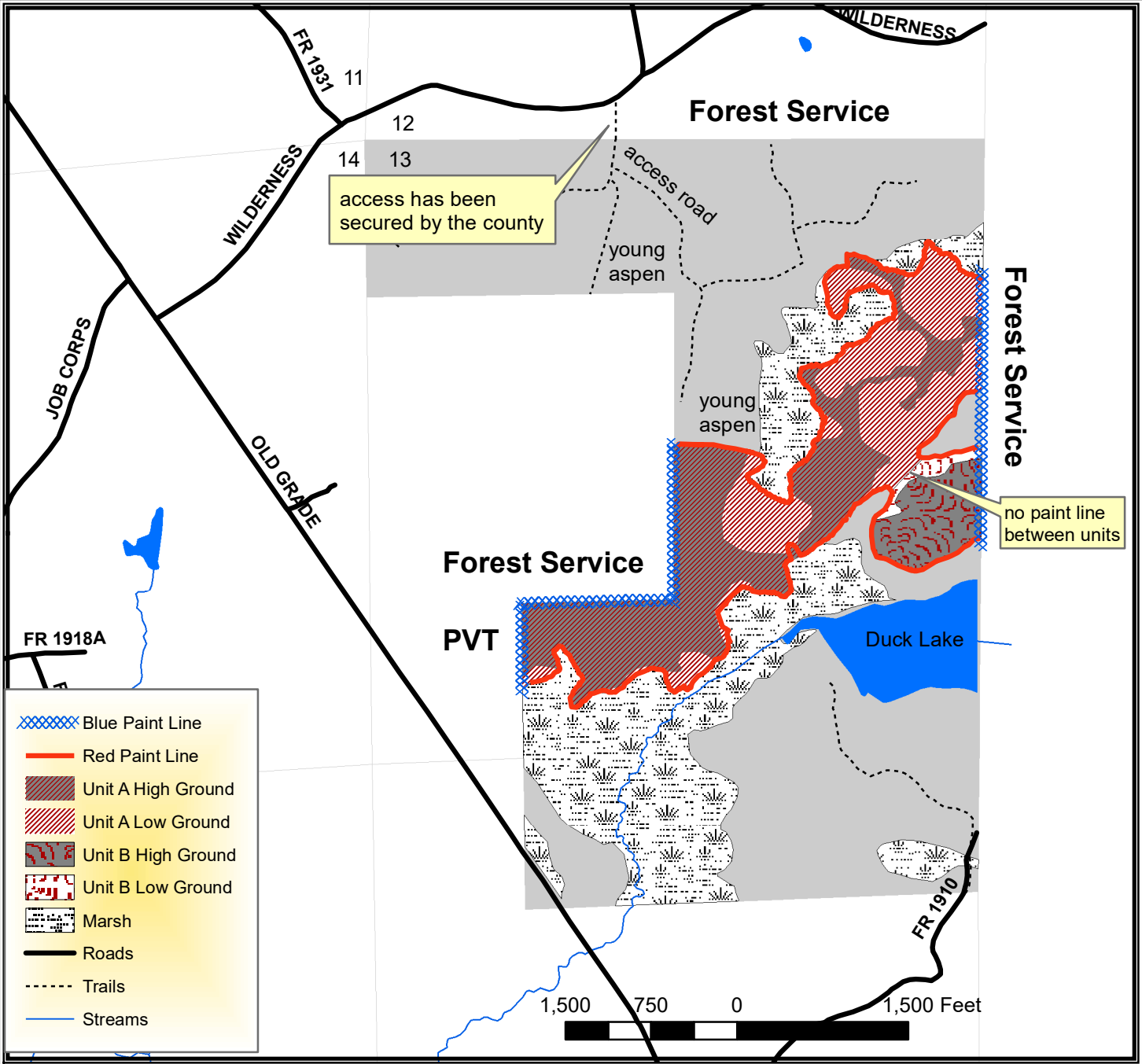

TRACT 51-19 – HARVEST REQUIREMENTS

The following terms and conditions supplement those provided in the Bayfield County Timber Sale Contract.

A. PRESCRIPTION:

1. Harvest unit A has a clearcut prescription with an estimated average residual basal area of 2 ft².
2. Harvest unit B has a seed tree prescription with an estimated average residual basal area of 16 ft².

B. HARVEST REQUIREMENTS:

1. In unit A, harvest all stems 2" and greater.
2. In unit B, harvest all stems 2" and greater.
3. In unit A, leave all red oak, white pine, red pine, cedar, and hemlock.
4. In unit B, leave all green painted trees, cedar, hemlock, white pine, and red pine.

C. OPERATIONAL REQUIREMENTS AND SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS:

1. Whole tree harvesting and/or utilization of tops (≤4" diameter) will not be allowed.
2. Sale operations may only occur when the ground is frozen or exceptionally dry conditions as determined by Bayfield County.

D. ACCESS AND ROADS:

1. Access off Wilderness Road through US Forest Service has been secured, but contractor must notify the county **4 weeks prior** to moving into the sale to allow the proper permits to be issued.
2. This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
3. Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.

E. OTHER:

1. **This sale will be sold as a three (3) year contract.**
2. To comply with Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
