

Free tax preparation offered in Washburn

The AARP Foundation, Bayfield County Dept. of Aging, the IRS and the Wisconsin Dept. of Revenue offers free tax preparation for individuals of all ages and income levels.

Where: Bayfield County Courthouse 117 E. 5th Street, Washburn, Wisconsin

When: Tuesdays February 4th to April 14th, 2020 from 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

This is a walk-in site with handicap and senior friendly parking available at the 6th street entrance. Returns will be prepared on a first come, first served basis.

Tax preparation is provided by IRS certified volunteers. The following returns are out of scope. We will not prepare the following returns: Married filing separately or final divorce in 2019, Active military or international returns, Part year WI residents or State returns other than Wisconsin, Small business returns with expenses exceeding \$10,00 depreciation or losses, Rental property, Foreign or Farm income, Schedule K with depreciation or deductible expenses.

Most other returns can be prepared including Homestead. If filing for Homestead a copy of your tax bill or an original Rent Certificate completed by your landlord with no errors or alterations is required. In addition, if you are under age 62 and have no earned income, you must provide documentation of disability.

Documents required include: a picture ID, Social Security cards for all dependents, all income statements and a check with routing and account number if direct deposit or debit is requested. It is highly recommended to bring last year's return.
