**CCS is available to
children and adults who
meet the following
criteria:**

- Are a resident of either Bayfield or Ashland County
- Are enrolled in Wisconsin Medicaid or BadgerCare Plus
- Have a mental health or substance use diagnosis made by a medical doctor
- Experience functional impairments that interfere with or limit one or more major life activities
- Are determined eligible through the State Mental Health/Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse Functional Screen at intake

WHAT IS CCS?

A recovery focused support program that provides mental health and substance use services to people of all ages. Assist a participant in identifying and achieving their behavioral health goals through supportive services. By partnering with a Service Facilitator and Recovery Team, the participant directs services needed to make progress towards their goals.

- Provides coordinated behavioral health and psychosocial rehabilitation services
- Assists individuals use of professional, community and natural supports to achieve their personal behavioral health goals
- Is recovery-focused and respects the participant's needs
- Creates an individualized recovery plan, a unique combination of the participant's direction and professional input
- Is a community based program where most services are provided in the participant's home and local community
- Can provide peer support services

PROGRAM SERVICES

Services provided under CCS are individually determined through the assessment and service planning process.

Service plans may address:

- Communication and interpersonal skills training
- Community skills development and enhancement
- Diagnostic evaluations and specialized assessments
- Employment related skills training
- Medication management
- Physical health and monitoring
- Psycho-education
- Psychotherapy
- Recovery education and illness management
- Substance abuse treatment
- Rehabilitative residential supports
- Crisis prevention and management

RECOVERY TEAM

An important part of CCS is the creation of a Recovery Team. A team is formed for each CCS participant. It includes the participant, a CCS Service Facilitator, a CCS Mental Health Professional (other professionals such as therapists, doctors or prescribers) and any other individuals such as a family member or friend the participant wishes to include on their Recovery Team for advocacy and support.

CCS VISION

- CCS vision is to provide psychosocial rehabilitation services to reduce negative behavioral health impacts and restore participants to the best possible level of functioning and independence
- CCS strives to provide flexible and consumer directed wraparound services
- CCS services focuses on supporting the participant living successfully in the community by addressing barriers to access employment, housing, transportation, health, educational, social, spiritual and recreational resources
- CCS participants take control of their lives and are assisted in developing resources and skills that make this a reality
- CCS strives to be culturally relevant and respectful of a participant's unique needs and values

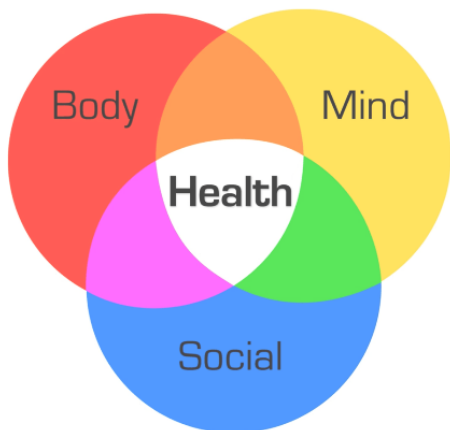


WHAT IS CCS?

A recovery focused behavioral health program for children and adolescents with mental illness, substance use disorders and/or severe emotional disturbance.

- Provides individualized, participant-centered service plans.
- Features a recovery based approach that includes family and other support.
- Is a community based program where most services are provided in the participant's home and local community.

Services are provided at no cost to participants.



PROGRAM SERVICES

Services are determined through assessment and individualized service planning.

Services Plans may include:

- Communication and interpersonal skills training
- Diagnostic evaluations and specialized assessments
- Medication management
- Physical health education, support and monitoring
- Social development and behavior modeling
- Individual and family psychotherapy; in the home, at school, or the CCS office
- Recovery education and illness management
- Substance abuse treatment
- Crisis prevention and management
- Education, training, and support for family members
- Support for an attainment of educational goals
- Mentoring
- Coordination with current providers and therapists

CCS VISION IS:

A flexible wraparound model that is directed by the youth and their family/guardians.

Services support the youth successful living in their community and access to health, education, social, spiritual and recreational resources.

Promotes meaningful participation of participants with family/guardians and chosen support systems.

Provides participants the skills to take better control of their lives they develop into adult citizens.

Identify service resources that build skills to allow participants to take responsibility for their decisions and actions that meet the needs of participants and their families.
