These sewn masks will help alleviate the shortage and will be distributed to help provide a protective barrier, so that medical-grade N95 masks may be conserved.

Pick Up/Drop off locations for free material and masks **Sites will be operational by noon on Friday March 27, 2020.

Ashland County Courthouse: Located at 201 Main Street West. Please drop off between the hours of 8am-5pm on the first floor on the table located outside the Ashland Extension Office.

City of Washburn: CoCo, located at 146 West Bayfield Street. Please drop off along the side of the building on the table provided under the overhang.

City of Bayfield: Encore, located at 10 South Broad Street-please leave on the back covered porch.

*Please return sewn masks in a plastic bag with your name, phone number and the number of masks included on the outside of the bag. It is important that volunteers collecting the masks not have to open the bags for their own protection.
